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Dear City of Goleta,

I am writing to express my support of a proposal to enact year-round street parking permits for Scripps Crescent, Mills Way, and adjacent streets. The parking problem on these streets has been getting worse, to the point that it is now grossly unsafe. With cars lining both sides of the street, it is difficult for two cars to safely pass while driving in opposite directions. Visibility is severely limited, especially at the intersections, where the traffic law prohibiting parking within 20 feet of an intersection is completely ignored. It is also very difficult for Marborg and delivery services to safely do their jobs.

During temporary permitting in past Halloween and Deltopia events, the parked cars in the neighborhood were dramatically reduced, proving that permanent permitting will solve the problem. I strongly recommend immediate consideration and enactment of this proposal to ensure both the safety and enjoyment of our neighborhood.
