SUBJECT: Annual Adjustments for User Fees and Charges for FY 2026/27

RECOMMENDATION:

- A. Conduct a Public Hearing on the Proposed User Fees and Charges; and
- B. Adopt Resolution No. 26-__ entitled “A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Goleta, California, Rescinding Resolution 25-12, Approving and Adopting the Fiscal Year 2026/2027 User Fees and Charges.”

BACKGROUND:

The current User Fees and Charges are based on an updated Cost Allocation Plan (CAP) and Comprehensive User Fee Study (Fee Study) that was presented to the City Council on April 20, 2021. The CAP and Fee Study were prepared by staff and Willdan Financial Services (Willdan). Willdan provided a detailed presentation on the cost-of-service methodology and analysis used to determine the full cost of providing City services. Based on the study, staff and consultants then presented the updated FY 2021/22 User Fees and Charges schedule which included a 1.6% Consumer Price Index (CPI) adjustment. The City Council then adopted Resolution No. 21-13 adopting the updated FY 2021/22 User Fees and Charges, which took effect on July 1, 2021.

Since FY 2021/22, staff has continued to present various cleanup items and updates that are identified throughout each fiscal year. With the adoption of each fiscal year’s user fees, the prior resolution is repealed. Most recently, a CPI increase of 3.3% was applied to the user fees on April 17, 2025, effective July 1, 2025, for FY 2025/26, under Resolution No. 25-12.

DISCUSSION:

The purpose of this item is to update the City’s user fees and charges schedule and recommend that the City Council adopt the updated fees for FY 2026/27, effective July 1, 2026.

User Fees and Charges Summary

A user fee is a payment made by an individual for a requested service that primarily benefits that individual, rather than the general public. For the City, they are considered charges for services, such as planning related services or services related to other City regulatory permits such as City business licenses, whereby those receiving the services from the City are required to pay the costs rather than burdening the residents. State law precludes charging more than the cost of providing the service. The updated user fees are based on a cost analysis and fee study performed by Willdan that was finalized in April 2021 and adjusted for a CPI increase. The fee study determined the full costs incurred by the City for providing services and examined whether a reasonable relationship existed between the costs of providing services and current service fees, while ensuring compliance with Proposition 26, Proposition 218, and other applicable statutory requirements. A copy of the fee study can be found on the City’s website.

Services and use of facilities and equipment should be based on a consideration of both direct and indirect cost to City of Goleta as well as the “market-based value” of the service. Flexibility is needed to maximize department revenues and to respond to changing market conditions such as demand versus capacity, weather, changes to the cost of providing the service, and/or additions or changes to existing programs. It is recommended that annual updates are made to the user fees, to account for any description updates or reflect any changes to the fee schedule and consider inflationary adjustments to keep up with full cost recovery.

Process of Updating City User Fees and Charges

Finance staff meet with each department to discuss their user fees to confirm any minor updates to descriptions for transparency or updates to their fee schedule. Fee updates can include changes in the process or activity involved in that fee type. Please note that the recommended rates are rounded to the nearest whole dollar, except for rates currently in cents. In addition, for clarity of the recommended change in rates and new fees, Attachment 1 - Exhibit A displays a column with the current rates and recommended rates with effective dates. This column with the current rates will not be a part of the permanent Exhibit of the adopting resolution or a part of the User Fees and Charges schedule that will be posted on the City’s website. Should the proposed rates be approved, the fees are recommended to be effective July 1, 2026.

Proposed Updates to the City's User Fees and Charges Schedule

The following section summarizes the recommended user fee updates by department and recommended CPI adjustment to applicable fees, to be effective July 1, 2026. This date reflects the earliest effective date for development-related fees, which is 60 days following the adoption of the fee. In addition, staff has added a new fee category for the Goleta Train Station opening, which is anticipated for August 2026.

Finance and Administration:

Staff is recommending changes to the existing fee schedule, as well as new fees to the FY 2026/27 User Fee Schedule. The changes are organized below by category.

New Fees:

- Non-Regulated Business License Request for Hearing Fee and Regulated Business License Request for Hearing Fee, which are both at a fee of \$482.00.
- Regulated licenses will have a municipal code section for a specific business license type, such as the tobacco retail license. For the regulated business license "Request for Hearing Fee", the Cannabis Business License will be excluded since a Cannabis Business License Appeal Fee already exists.
- Single Day Vendor Permit, which will capture any business participating in a single-day event at a fee of \$25.00 a day.
- Umbrella Vendor Permit - For events with multiple businesses or vendors. This fee would be calculated as follows: (number of vendors x number of days x \$25.00). For example, 15 vendors x 2 days x \$25.00 = \$750.00.
- Umbrella Vendor Permit-Non-Profit - Fee is recommended at no cost to subsidize non-profit events.

Fee Line Additions for Transparency:

- The schedule now displays an added fee line for Short-Term Vacation Rental License – Renewal, which is the same rate as a new business license fee in the amount of \$384.00.

Fee Name Updates:

- Cannabis Business License Appeal - Added "Fee" to the name.
- Massage Establishment Business License (New and Renewal) - Added "(Non-State Certified)" to both.
- Massage Technician Business License-New and Renewal - Added "(Non-State Certified)" to both.
- Taxicab Operator - The term "Business License" has been added to the fee's name.

Neighborhood Services:

Staff is not recommending CPI adjustments for any of the Neighborhood Service Fees section to encourage community use.

New Fees:

- NEPA Environmental Review (HUD CPF/EDI) - This will require a \$1,000.00 deposit, and the actual cost will be charged for this review request. Costs associated with conducting National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) environmental reviews for Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Project Funding (CPF) Economic Development Initiative (EDI) grants within Goleta city limits. The fee is to recover the City's administrative costs, as the HUD Responsible Entity under 24 CFR Part 58, for completing required environmental review and clearance steps. This includes preparation of the Environmental Review Record (ERR), applicable compliance determinations and agency consultations, public noticing, and submission of the Request for Release of Funds (RROF), as applicable.

Neighborhood Services – Goleta Community Center:

Staff is not recommending CPI adjustments for the Goleta Community Center (GCC). Fees for the GCC were established just over a year ago and are still new to the patrons. Therefore, keeping prices stable may encourage more engagement with the GCC. The department is also suggesting we consider the staff time and material costs when changing prices in each fiscal year. There would be significant staff time to enter all the changes in the Parks & Recreation software system, Xplor, in addition to any printed materials that require updates.

Fee Name Updates:

- Field Rental – Renamed to “Field & Court Rental”, which is to capture both rental of fields and pickleball courts.

New Fees:

- Sunday Six (6)-Hour Package (Auditorium, Dining Hall, Courtyard w/ Alcohol) – New package fee for Private, Commercial, and Non-profit use ranging from \$828.00 to \$1,104.00. This new package will offer a discount by not charging additional fees for Sunday bookings, which remain difficult to rent.
- Exhibit Fee - The GCC will be offering outside agencies the opportunity to exhibit at City-run events. The new fees consist of an Exhibitor Fee with a range of \$25.00 to \$200.00 (depending on the size, duration, marketing, and City Staff time necessary to put on the event) for an outside agency to exhibit at a City-run event. City staff will set an amount for each event and charge it to all exhibits for that event.
- Ongoing Contract Change Fee – \$25.00 cover staff time to process the change.

Library:

Staff is not recommending CPI adjustments for fees related to the library due to the cost of updating materials with new fee rates, as well as the renovations and relocation of the Library. The staff would like fees to remain the same, considering a decrease in patron visits.

New Fees:

- Unreturned or Lost Materials – Teen Books - \$36.00. This fee is to recover the cost of a lost or damaged library book and ensure that an exact or comparable replacement title can be added to the collection for continued patron use. This fee is based on the market value of teen print materials, the average of current fees for Unreturned or Lost Juvenile and Adult materials, and staff time to replace the item.

Public Works:

Staff is recommending some changes to their fees to improve the fee calculation for staff as well as applicants. Staff is also recommending several new fees for FY 2026/27. The following changes are organized by fee category.

Residential Encroachment Permit Fees:

- New or Replacement Residential Driveway (New Fee) – \$300.00. This fee was accidentally omitted in the FY 2025/26 Fee update.
- Residential Encroachment Permit – No increase recommended to the current \$400.00 fee, since this is a new fee, effective with the FY 2025/26 user fee update, and was initially set at a rounded amount to cover costs.

Commercial Encroachment Permit Fees:

- Basic Encroachment Permit – No increase recommended to the current \$400.00 fee, since this is a new fee, effective with the FY 2025/26 user fee update, and was initially set at a rounded amount to cover costs.
- New and Replacement Commercial Driveway – Fee will increase from \$451.00 to \$750.00 to align with the Santa Barbara (SB) County fees and allow for cost recovery. The total SB County fee is \$1,366.00, which includes the basic encroachment permit application fee and the New/Replacement Commercial Driveway fee, compared to the City of Goleta fee of \$1,150.00 (\$400.00 for the basic encroachment permit fee + \$750.00 for the new/replacement commercial driveway fee).
- New or Replacement Sidewalk – Name change to add “50 square feet or less.” A new fee has been added for New or Replacement of Sidewalk – Between 51

square feet and 500 square feet, in the amount of \$800.00. For projects greater than 500 square feet, the Engineer's estimate will determine the fee.

- New or Replacement of Curb and Gutter – Name updated to include “20 Linear feet or less”. A new fee for New or Replacement of Curb and Gutter – Between 21 linear feet and 100 linear feet in the amount of \$800.00. This new fee will replace the additional fee of \$0.50 per linear foot in excess of 50 square feet. For projects greater than 100 linear feet, the Engineer's estimate will determine the fee.

Trench Fees:

The use of Cubic Yards in the measurement for Within Paved Roadway and Outside of Paved Roadway Excavation has been removed and replaced with the following new fees:

- Trenching/Potholing (Including Trenchless Technology) 100 Linear Feet or Less – \$800.00
- Pavement Cut Fee associated with Linear Feet Trenching (including Trenchless Technology) – \$1.00 per Linear Foot.

Public Road Improvement Plan Review and Construction Inspection:

- Tier description name changes – Name change added to include tier descriptions for the fees, based on the percentage of the cost of construction, to help clarify the fee levels. For example, the “Next \$30,000” fee now includes “Between \$20,001 and \$50,000”.
- Plan Review, Inspection, and Material Testing – Revised deposit amount from \$5,000.00 to \$8,000.00, to help complete a customer's case when the department is unsure of the completion time.

Public Safety and Convenience Fees – Traffic Control Plan Review:

- Major Traffic Control Plan Review – Increased from \$846.00 to \$920.00 to capture actual costs. The description “(Requires Traffic Engineer's review)” has been removed.
- Minor Traffic Control Plan Review – Increased from \$204.00 to \$300.00 to capture actual costs. The description “(over-the-counter permit)” has been removed.
- Required Night Work – Description updated to include “per night,” with a clarifying note that the nightly fee will be provided at time of request, based on actual costs.

Other Changes:

- Monitoring Well Installation/ Abandonment per Location – Moved from the Monitoring Well Section to the Annual Permits section.
- Amtrak Bike Locker Key Deposit – Fee has been removed.

- Commemorative Bench Deposit – Fee has been removed, and a commemorative object program will be considered part of the future updated Donation, Sponsorship, and Gift Policy.

Planning and Environmental Review:

Staff is recommending a few new fees to be added to the FY 2026/27 User Fee Schedule.

New Fees – Ministerial Section:

- Land Use Permit (LUP) – General – \$1,656.00 deposit, to be used with routine LUPs.
- LUP – Projects Using Objective Design Standards – \$5,520.00 deposit, for ministerial housing projects in the Residential High Density (RH) zoning district that use Objective Design Standards (ODS).

New Fees – Hearing Section:

- Public Art Fee – \$600 per hearing, for review of public art projects on private developments based on the Public Art Policy, this fee is waived for city-owned or city-funded public art projects.

Building and Safety:

The department has recommended a slight modification to the Minimum Fee names to help determine which fees are related to a heat pump for a single-family residence.

- Minimum Permit Fee – Heat Pump (Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing) – \$85.00 each. This change will help staff to differentiate the fee for staff in anticipation of the new reimbursement policy for a Heat Pump Permit for a single-family residence.
- Plans Duplication Request - \$162.00 per professional.
- Code Enforcement Violation (work done without permits) – Fee equal to double the original permit.

Goleta Train Station:

In anticipation of the grand opening of the new Goleta Train Station, a new fee schedule has been created. The new fees are modeled after the Goleta Community Center fee schedule, which includes equipment and room rental fees with their associated deposits. However, these fees are for the single and only rental space at the Goleta Train Station. A detailed fee schedule is provided in Attachment 1- Exhibit A. Since this is a new facility, staff anticipates future updates and new fees as operations and functionality of the facility are further developed.

User Fees Subject to CPI Adjustment:

Since 2010, the City's user fees and charges have continued to be adjusted and adopted annually by the prior year's change in the CPI for All Urban Consumers for the Los Angeles-Long Beach-Anaheim area. In 2026, the annual CPI increase is 3.2%. Table 1 below summarizes the annual CPI history reported by the Bureau of Labor Statistics and includes the date the City's CPI fee adjustment became effective, and the corresponding fiscal year.

A CPI adjustment to fees is a recommended best practice to ensure cost recovery keeps up with inflation. Furthermore, each year that transpires without modification of the rates to reflect the cost of doing business results in a loss of revenues that cannot be recovered retroactively and is therefore borne by the City's General Fund.

Staff has provided supplemental user fee schedules incorporating the 3.2% CPI increase. The schedule shows a side-by-side comparison and the potential changes to the fees if Council adopts the recommended user fees and the 3.2% CPI increase. These schedules are found in Attachment 1 - Exhibit A.

It should be noted that not all user fees are recommended for CPI adjustment, which is due to fee limits per state mandates and local agreements with the County of Santa Barbara. This is separate from any staff recommendations described above that may specifically request not to increase a particular fee

Public Notice Requirement

The user fees include both development and non-development fees. A public hearing is required for fee revisions. A public hearing notice was published in accordance with California Government Code section 6066 for a hearing at this April 21, 2026, regularly scheduled City Council meeting to adopt a resolution that confirms and updates the user fees and charges. The notice was published in the *Santa Barbara Independent* on April 9, 2026, and April 16, 2026. Additionally, it was made available for public review on the City's website.

Effective Date and Future Fee Updates

Staff is recommending an effective date of July 1, 2026, for all fees. This will enable staff sufficient time to update forms, applications, websites, and computer software as necessary for the fee updates.

The next annual user fee update is anticipated to be considered on April 7, 2027, to be effective for July 1, 2027, for FY 2027/28.

It is recommended that a comprehensive review of the cost of services and fees be performed every three to five years. The next Comprehensive User Fee Study and Full Cost Allocation Plan Update is anticipated to begin in FY 2026/27 and be reviewed with Council in FY 2027/28.

Annual Fee Adjustment Issues

The CAP and User Fee Study were based on FY 2018/19 amended budgeted figures. Fees should be updated periodically to account for changes in costs and processes over time. The development and use of an annual fee increase mechanism normally provides a level of convenience and efficiency as staff does not have the time to recalculate cost recovery percentages on an annual basis and costs to have a consultant recalculate percentages can be prohibitive, yet the annual fee increase recovers some of the cost increases. To ensure that the City receives appropriate fee increases that reflect the actual growth in cost, staff is recommending continued use of the current CPI factor which is the annual change in CPI of All Urban Consumers for the Los Angeles-Long Beach-Anaheim area, as produced by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. It should be noted that other inflationary factors can be employed. Since the primary factor for the cost of a city's service is usually driven by the costs of personnel involved, tying an inflationary factor that connects more directly to personnel costs can be suitable if there is a clear method or current practice of obtaining this type of factor. Staff will continue evaluating this in the future and will have future discussions with the Finance Committee.

Possible Fee Subsidies

The following table summarizes previously adopted fee subsidies, established through prior City Council action on fees or ordinances. Most recently added to the subsidy list is the Public Art Review for City-Funded/City-Owned Projects that was approved by Council

on October 7, 2025, and the Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing Minimum Permits related to Heat Pump Fees that was approved by Council on June 3, 2025.

There are also various exemptions of fees related to film permits per the Goleta Municipal Code Section 12.05.040, where the City issues permits for student films and non-profit organizations with fees waived upon proof of student or non-profit status and insurance.	

Note: While not included or part of the user fee and charges schedule, there are other fee subsidies and waivers related to development impact fees (DIFs) for beneficial projects approved by the City Council. On July 16, 2019, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 19-43, which established a list of Beneficial Projects that would be eligible for either a complete waiver of DIFs or a reduction in the required fees. On December 20, 2022, Resolution No. 19-43 was amended by Resolution No. 22-68. Additional details can be found on the City's website.

The final suggested fee amounts were determined by each department, with most fees set at or near 100% full cost recovery.

Council will also be reviewing the Cost Recovery Policy and User Fee Setting Policy at a later City Council meeting. A draft was recently reviewed with the Finance Committee and is being further refined. This policy work addresses broader questions, including whether certain fee subsidies should be established for specific user groups (e.g., non-profit organizations involved in projects that generate a community benefit and were part of

beneficial project types under the City's DIF waiver resolution, and also evaluating if certain fee levels might discourage compliance with regulatory requirements).

It is important for the City and the public to understand that another revenue source, such as the General Fund, must cover subsidies. Therefore, the general taxpayer will potentially help to fund private benefits, and/or other City services will not receive funds that are otherwise directed to cover subsidies.

FINANCE COMMITTEE REVIEW:

The Finance Committee met to review the adjustments to the City's User Fees and Charges Schedule on April 9, 2026.

FISCAL IMPACTS:

Approving the updated recommended user fees and charges discussed above will allow the City to aim towards full cost recovery. Actual cost recovery is dependent upon actual activity in requests for those services.

There are two types of fee structures used by the City: fixed/flat fees or deposit-based fees.

- 1) Fixed or flat fees are used for services and facilities that do not vary greatly in scope. Most flat fees are set at or near full cost recovery based on the cost of providing the service. For facility and equipment rentals, such as those at the Goleta Community Center and Goleta Train Station, flat fees are based on adjusted market rates for comparable rental spaces, with tiered pricing for private, commercial, and non-profit use.
- 2) Deposit-based fees allow for more precise accounting of costs on a project-by-project basis, which helps ensure nearly 100% full cost recovery. The fees that are deposit-based start with an initial deposit amount and charges are made when activity occurs. Depending on the activity relative to the deposit fee, additional deposits may be requested to ensure adequate funds are collected before services are rendered. At the end of the service, any unused deposit amount would then be refunded to the applicant. Deposit-based fees are also the most staff time intensive as they require manual setup of accounts to track specific activity and user information, along with refunding or billing an applicant.

Certain fees are subsidized for specific user groups, as outlined in the Discussion section. Where fees are reduced or waived, such as for non-profit organizations, schools, public art review, and residential heat pump projects, the General Fund absorbs the difference between the subsidized rate and the full cost of providing the service.

Overall revenue increases are difficult to estimate due to the change in activity levels from year to year. Currently, staff projects the fee updates could result in an increase of

\$10,000 to \$100,000. Primarily, adopting these updated fees would help ensure the City is pursuing full cost recovery.

ALTERNATIVES:

The City Council could take no action, thereby maintaining the current user fees and charges, resulting in specific fees not being charged and impacting the General Fund.

RESOLUTION NO 26-__

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLETA, CALIFORNIA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION 25-12, APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2026/2027 USER FEES AND CHARGES

WHEREAS, the City of Goleta (the “City”) charges fees for various services, permits, licenses, and regulatory activity provided by the City (collectively, the “Fees”); and

WHEREAS, in order for the Fees to cover the costs of providing the services, permits, licenses, or regulatory activity for which the Fees are imposed, many of the Fees must be adjusted to reflect reasonable estimated costs of service; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to reclassify its Fees and repeal resolutions to accomplish this goal, and now wishes to readopt the Fees as set forth in Exhibit A, effective July 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously authorized the use of credit card for its customers to pay for City services; and

WHEREAS, there are certain transactional costs associated with the use of this payment method; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 6159, the City may impose a charge for the transactional costs associated with the use of such method; and

WHEREAS, such a charge or fee is subject to the procedures set forth in Government Code section 66018; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Government Code section 66018, the City Council held a public hearing for April 21, 2026, for the purpose of receiving public comments on the proposed fees. Notice of the public hearing was given by publication in a newspaper of general circulation within the City once a week for two weeks commencing at least 10 days prior to the public hearing, with at least 5 days intervening between the first and last publication. On April 21, 2026, at the time and place set for the public hearing, the City Council heard and considered all oral and written presentations and comments made regarding the proposed fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLETA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings.

The above Recitals are true and correct and by this reference incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. Adoption of User Fees.

The City Council hereby adopts the full City of Goleta Comprehensive User Fees and Charges Schedule described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The Fees imposed by this Resolution shall take effect on July 1, 2026 and are subject to a 3.2% CPI increase and supersede any prior fees or charges imposed by resolution or otherwise by the City Council, to the extent such prior fees or charges conflict herewith.

SECTION 3. Comprehensive Fee Resolution.

This resolution shall be known as the Comprehensive Fee Resolution.

SECTION 4. The City Council held a public hearing on April 21, 2026, for the purpose of receiving public comments to the proposed fees. Notice of the public hearing was given by publication in a newspaper of general circulation within the City once a week for two weeks commencing at least 10 days prior to the public hearing, with at least 5 days intervening between the first and last publication. On April 21, 2026, at the time and place set for the public hearing, the City Council heard and considered all oral and written presentations and comments made regarding the proposed fees.

SECTION 5: The City Council finds and determines that:

- (a) The Fees established by this resolution:
 - (1) are imposed for a specific government service provided directly to the payor, or for reasonable regulatory costs of the City for issuing licenses and permits, performing investigations, inspections, and administrative enforcement of the City's Municipal Code or other rules or ordinances.
 - (2) are no more than necessary to cover the reasonable costs of the governmental activity for which the Fee is imposed; and
 - (3) the manner in which those costs are allocated to a payor bear a fair or reasonable relationship to the payor's burdens on, or benefits received from, the governmental activity for which the Fee is imposed; and
- (b) The Fees are not taxes within the meaning of California Constitution article XIII C, section 1(e).

SECTION 6. If any section, subsection, clause or phrase in this resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is for any reason held invalid, the validity of the remainder of this resolution or the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases or the application thereof to any person or circumstance be held invalid.

SECTION 7. Should the City accept payment of any fee identified in Exhibit A of this Resolution, as it may be amended from time to time, by means of credit card in lieu of check or cash, the City shall impose a separate fee equal to three percent (3%) or actual cost charged to the City of the transaction amount as a convenience fee for processing the payment. The City Council finds and determines that accessibility to the library, parks and recreation programs, and train station facilities, benefit the community and serve a public purpose. Accordingly, a credit card convenience fee shall not be charged for library, parks and recreation, and train station related fees. In no event shall the convenience fee exceed the actual transactional costs incurred by the City in providing for the payment by credit card. When the City accepts payment by means of credit card, it shall also accept payment by means of check or cash.

SECTION 8. The City Manager and Director of Finance are hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to implement and collect the Fees and the credit card convenience fee. Additionally, City Manager and Director of Finance are authorized to make ministerial corrections to the Comprehensive User Fees and Charges Schedule, to remedy typographical, clerical, or mathematical errors identified during the preparation or publication of the Schedule, provided that: (a) any such correction is consistent with the fee amounts intended by the City Council as reflected in the underlying cost-of-service study and CPI adjustment of 3.2% authorized by this Resolution; (b) no correction shall result in establishment of a new fee or increase in any fee beyond what was approved by the City Council; and (c) a written record of any correction, including an explanation of the error for the corrected amount, shall be maintained by the Director of Finance or designee, and reported to the City Council at the next regular meeting.

SECTION 9. Resolutions 25-12 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 10. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

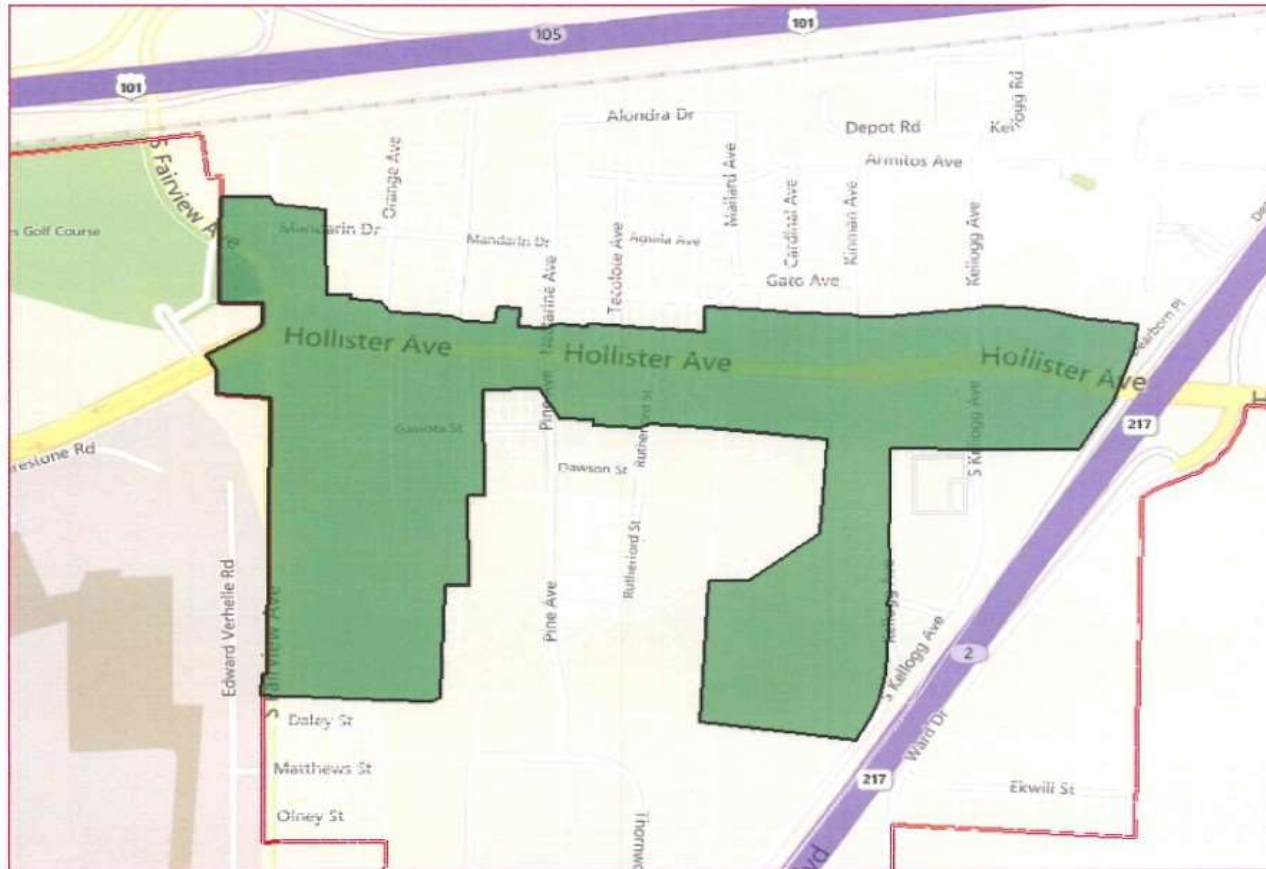

User Fees Background

- User Fees are charges for services and regulatory fees – planning services, permit fees, library fees, business licenses
- Based on Cost Allocation Plan (CAP) and User Fee Study conducted by Willdan Financial Services presented on April 20, 2021, which took effect FY 21/22
- Fees should recover costs
- State law precludes charging more than the cost of providing service
- Public Hearing required with revision to its fees

A public notice was published for this hearing in the Santa Barbara Independent on April 9, 2026, and April 16, 2026 .

- **Recommending CPI increase of 3.2% effective July 1, 2026**
