SUBJECT: Interviews of Candidates for the Public Engagement Commission

and the Public Tree Advisory Commission

RECOMMENDATION:

A. Conduct candidate interviews for the Public Engagement Commission and the Public Tree Advisory; and

- B. Select one nominee for the Public Engagement Commission Mayoral Appointment; and
- C. Select two nominees for the Public Tree Advisory Commission Mayoral Appointment; and
- D. Continue this item to the February 4, 2025, City Council meeting for ratification of one Mayoral Appointment to the Public Engagement Commission and two Mayoral Appointments to the Public Tree Advisory Commission.

BACKGROUND:

Public Engagement Commission

The Public Engagement Commission is authorized by Goleta Municipal Code Section 2.19.20. The purpose of the Public Engagement Commission shall be to advise the City Council and staff on matters related to public engagement in City government and governance. The Public Engagement Commission shall be composed of seven (7) members. One member shall be a Youth Member. Members of the Public Engagement Commission shall be appointed to a four-year term. There shall be no limit on the number of terms members may be appointed. The Youth Commissioner shall serve up to a two-year term.

On November 20, 2024, Beth Schneider whose term ends November 2027, submitted her resignation for the Public Engagement Commission.

Public Tree Advisory Commission

The Public Tree Advisory Commission is authorized by Goleta Municipal Code Section 2.11.020. The purpose of the Public Tree Advisory Commission shall be to hear appeals of decisions on the planting and removal of public trees as provided under Section 2.11.010, and to provide advice to staff and the City Council on matters related to the Goleta Urban Forest. The Public Tree Advisory Commission shall be composed of five members.

The terms of Lindsay Lucera (Resident) and Jessica Altstatt (Resident) expire February 2025. On November 8, 2024, Lindsay Lucera notified staff that she would not be seeking another term on the Public Tree Advisory Commission. Jessica Alstatt, who is unable to attend due to scheduling conflicts has resubmitted her application for consideration.

DISCUSSION:

Appointments to the Public Engagement Commission and the Public Tree Advisory Commission, follow the normal appointment process under GMC Section 2.15.040 (B). At the conclusion of all interviews, each Councilmember shall announce the Councilmember's preferred candidate(s) for the interviewed position(s). The City Clerk shall compile a list of candidates for each vacancy based on the Councilmembers' selections. The Mayor may then appoint from among the recommended candidates.

In anticipation of the expiring terms for the, the City Clerk's office published requests for candidate applications on the City website, the Monarch Press, Channel 19, the local adjudicated newspaper, GovDelivery Bulletins, social media sites, and generated press releases.

I am interested in serving on the City of Goleta's Public Engagement Commission because I want to participate in engaging the public on matters that directly impact our community's quality of life. I wholeheartedly believe in civic engagement to help community members grow and develop agency and self-determination. My background in community organizing, mediation & conflict resolution, education, and business management would allow me to contribute meaningfully and thoughtfully. I am particularly passionate about engaging communities that are often hidden or absent from city dialogue and believe that I will be a collaborative member of the Public Engagement Commission.

I am interested in serving on the Public Engagement Commission because my experience uniquely positions me to contribute meaningfully to community governance. As a Community Psychologist, I apply evidence-based approaches to address social issues aiming to promote positive change and empower.
