Greetings from St. Mark's University Parish! Indeed, I have had the privilege of knowing Mr. McDevitt in both a professional and personal capacity for several years, as he is the Facilities Manager and a long-time parishioner here at St. Mark's University Parish where I now presently serve. Since my own appointment to the parish in 2021, I have come to know Mike, his family, and his character quite well, all of which inspires this present letter.

Sports have been a major part of Mike's life, as seen in his successful career as a hockey referee at the collegiate, national, and international levels—a career which extends to his continued refereeing at the college-level now and to his participation in local adult leagues as well as national tournaments. With such a background, he would obviously be a desirable candidate for such a committee, as experience is so very valuable in these types of roles. And so, insofar as I may, I write now in order to offer my own recommendation for Mr. McDevitt to be appointed to the Parks and Recreation Commission for the City of Goleta.
