SUBJECT: Annual Adjustments for User Fees and Charges for FY 2025/26

RECOMMENDATION:

- A. Conduct a Public Hearing on the Proposed User Fees and Charges; and
- B. Adopt Resolution No. 25-__ entitled "A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Goleta, California, Rescinding Resolution 24-23, Approving and Adopting the Fiscal Year 2025/2026 User Fees and Charges."

BACKGROUND:

The current User Fees and Charges are based on an updated Cost Allocation Plan (CAP) and Comprehensive User Fee Study (Fee Study) that was presented to the City Council on April 20, 2021. The CAP and Fee Study were prepared by staff and Willdan Financial Services (Willdan). Willdan provided a detailed presentation on the cost-of-service methodology and analysis used to determine the full cost of providing City services. Based on the study, staff and consultants then presented the updated FY 2021/22 User Fees and Charges schedule which included a 1.6% Consumer Price Index (CPI) adjustment. The City Council then adopted Resolution No. 21-13 adopting the updated FY 2021/22 User Fees and Charges, which took effect on July 1, 2021.

Since 2021/22, staff has continued to present various cleanup items and updates that are identified throughout each fiscal year. With the adoption of each fiscal year's user fees, the prior resolution is repealed. Most recently, a CPI increase of 3.5% was applied to the user fees on April 16, 2024, effective from July 1, 2024, for FY 2024/25, under Resolution No. 24-23.

DISCUSSION:

The purpose of this item is to update the City's user fees and charges schedule and recommend that the City Council adopt the updated fees for FY 2025/26, effective July 1, 2025.

User Fees and Charges Summary

A user fee is a payment made by an individual for a requested service that primarily benefits that individual, rather than the general public. For the City, they are considered charges for services, such as planning related services or services related to other City regulatory permits such as City business licenses, whereby those receiving the services from the City are required to pay the costs rather than burdening the residents. State law precludes charging more than the cost of providing the service. The updated user fees are based on a cost analysis and fee study performed by Willdan that was finalized in April 2021 and adjusted for a CPI increase. The fee study determined the full costs incurred by the City for providing services and examined whether a reasonable relationship existed between the costs of providing services and current service fees, while ensuring compliance with Proposition 26, Proposition 218, and other applicable statutory requirements. A copy of the fee study can be found on the City's website.

Services and use of facilities and equipment should be based on a consideration of both direct and indirect cost to City of Goleta as well as the "market-based value" of the service. Flexibility is needed to maximize department revenues and to respond to changing market conditions such as demand versus capacity, weather, changes to the cost of providing the service, and/or additions or changes to existing programs. It is recommended that annual updates are made to the user fees, to account for any description updates or reflect any changes to the fee schedule and consider inflationary adjustments to keep up with full cost recovery.

Process of Updating City User Fees and Charges

Finance staff meets with each department and discusses their user fees to confirm any minor updates to descriptions for transparency or updates to their fee schedule. Fee updates can include changes in process or activity involved in that fee type. Please note that the recommended rates are rounded to the nearest whole dollar, except for rates currently in cents. In addition, for clarity of the recommended change in rates and new fees, Attachment 1 - Exhibit A displays a column with the current rates and recommended rates with effective dates. This column with the current rates will not be a part of the permanent Exhibit of the adopting resolution or a part of the User Fees and Charges schedule that will be posted on the City's website. Should the proposed rates be approved, the fees are recommended to be effective July 1, 2025.

Proposed Updates to the City's User Fees and Charges Schedule

The following section summarizes the recommended user fee updates by department and recommended CPI adjustment to applicable fees, to be effective July 1, 2025. This date reflects the earliest effective date for development-related fees, which is 60 days following the adoption of the fee. In addition, it provides clarity on certain fee categories such as with Community Center.

Finance and Administration:

Staff is recommending changes to existing fees, as well as new fees to the FY 25/26 User Fee Schedule. A new Short-Term Vacation License Appeal fee to capture an appeal process which is in line with a similar appeal process fee Land Use Entitlement Permit Appeal fee. A fee reduction has been recommended for both the Massage Technician Business License (State Certified) and the Massage Establishment Business License (State Certified), New and Renewal fees, from \$350 to \$137.00 to reflect rate decrease in line with the General License applicant fees. State-Certified technicians and businesses have already gone through an extensive certification process which we want to recognize in this fee reduction. For transparency purposes, the schedule has added a variety of penalties that have already been established via the Goleta Municipal Code. These would include Cannabis Tax Delinquency Fees, and Transient Occupancy Tax Delinquency Fees, and Tobacco License Late Fees. Although a specific interest rate for a cannabis tax delinquency was not explicitly stated in the Municipal Code, staff is recommending an interest rate of one half of one percent (0.005%), which would be in line with neighboring jurisdictions.

Neighborhood Services

Staff is not recommending CPI adjustments for most fees related to the Park Reservations section to encourage community use. Consumer Price Index adjustments will remain in place for all other fees related to Special Event Permits and Pyrotechnic Fees.

Neighborhood Services – Community Center:

Staff is recommending no CPI adjustments for the Spaces and Packages sections. Fees to the Community Center were established less than a year ago and are still new to the patrons. Therefore, keeping prices stable may encourage more engagement with the Community Center.

Under the Other Fees section, staff is recommending existing fees remain the same except for the two Cleaning Fees for events which will be increased to be more in line with actual cost. A new Display Fee will be added for Non-profit organizations at \$100 per month. The Community Center currently has several display areas to promote the community opportunities available to patrons. Staff is also recommending Class Fees, with a Minimum and Maximum range that are ultimately based on the instructor's cost to the City. These Class Fees will incorporate a 20% discount for residents, while non-resident will be charged the higher amount.

Library:

The department is recommending a few updates of the Unreturned or Lost Material section. The first recommendation is to update the Unreturned or Lost Materials-Books on CD to include, "Read-Along," for transparency to help clarify the media's definition. Staff has recommended adding an Unreturned or Lost Materials Book Club Kit Individual Copy Fee to capture when a patron has only lost an individual copy of the book kit, which had not previously been called out with relevance to the cost of operations. The fee will be the actual cost of the missing book. A California State Parks Pass Replacement fee had previously been labeled "Actual Costs" but is now displayed at \$55 to be consistent with the Museum Pass Replacement fee. The rental fee of \$0 for a California State Parks Pass has been removed to avoid confusing patrons, considering most library items are free to rent. Staff has requested that the Note Fee the Collection Agency Referral fee be updated from "Accounts with fees over \$40 due for 30 days or more" to "Accounts with fees over \$40 due for to 73 days or more" in order to be more in line of the library's procedures.

Under the Charges for Meeting Room Space section, the room name will be updated to reflect the actual name of the room from "Community Room" to "Multipurpose Room". Staff also recommends removing (if cleanup required) from the "Refreshments in Meeting Rooms", this will be more in line with the current library practice.

Public Works:

Staff is recommending several changes to the outline of their fees to better direct patrons to all potential fees per category.

Under the Encroachment Permit (EP) Fees section there will be a category for Residential and Commercial. Under Residential Encroachment Permit Fees, staff recommends adding a fee for \$400 which captures any improvements along property frontage of a single family residence. This fee is replacing Minor Construction and Minimum Inspection fee. The same consolidation is also recommended for the Commercial Encroachment Permit Fees section. However, it will be called the Basic Encroachment Permit Application Fee. The Commercial Driveway fee and Sidewalk fee will have a name change of adding, "New or Replacement of," to the beginning of the name for clarification. Staff also has added a new fee for New or Replacement of Curb and Gutter in the amount of \$320, which also includes an additional fee of \$0.50 per linear foot in excess of 50 sq. ft. which is in line for the Commercial Driveway fee. This fee is added because there was no previous fee for this type of work.

Under the Trench Fee section of the fees, a new sub-section has been requested for Public Road Improvement Plan Review and Construction Inspection, Including Test materials. Staff is recommending a new deposit fee, Plan Review, Inspection and Material Testing Fee, which will help complete a customer's case when the department is unsure of the completion time.

The Public Safety and Convenience Fees-Traffic Control Plan Review section has added the Road Closure Permit (greater than 5 days), as well as the Required Night Work Fee, to help capture the various timing differences that can exist for providing the traffic control service.

Under section Post Permit issuance/Failure to Obtain/Appeal Fees, both fees Work without Permit and Work without Calling for Inspection have been updated to a dollar amount of \$800, which had previously stated, “two times the regular fee.” Notes have been added to clarify the EP that the calculation is based on.

Under the Transportation and Haul Permits section, the fee Haul Routes More Than One Month has been modified to 20 days to clarify the process and to be more in line with the descriptions of the other Haul Routes fees.

Under section Annual Permits, staff has recommended a new Wireless Encroachment Permit Deposit to cover annual activity per application with an updated amount of \$10,000 instead of \$2,508, which is in line with Resolution 19-26. This change will reduce the amount of deposits required to process. Any unused balance will be returned to the applicant. Staff would still require the new Wireless Encroachment Permit Issuance fee per location to be paid along with the companies’ deposits. A new line item for CalTrans or Santa Barbara County Annual Traffic Control Set up Permit will be required as well as per location. However, there is no cost associated with this fee.

Under the section Film Permits, all fees have been adjusted to capture industry standards with fees for Motion and Still Photo options. In addition to revamping the Film permit section, a subsection for Parking/Driving City Streets has been added to capture various activities such as drone and vehicles fees associated with the film. A third subsection has been added for informational purposes to direct patrons to other fees they may be required to have that relate to City or other government agencies.

Planning and Environmental Review:

Fees have been edited for clarification to specify a specific dollar amount. For example, the Zoning Clearance – Revision fee was originally labeled, “50% of Zoning Clearance fee,” but now those calculations have been made to display, “\$513.00.”

A new fee of Land Use Permit – Ministerial Housing Projects has been added to reflect review process for housing projects based on State housing laws.

The department is recommending consolidation of the Tentative Parcel Map fee and Tentative Tract Map fee into just Tentative Map fee. The work done is essentially the same, but the difference tends to be the amount of time spent given the level of specificity and scope between a Parcel Map (4 or fewer lots) and Tract Map (5 or more lots). The same consolidation would be applied to the Map Clearance – Tentative Map and Map Clearance – Parcel Map, which would be combined to just Map Clearance – Map fee.

Building and Safety:

The department has recommended a slight modification to how the fees are rounded mathematically. Due to the frequent customers and various permits involved, staff believe response times for building permit estimates can be efficient if staff can reference a fee amount that is rounded to the nearest fifty cents.

Staff has also recommended that the permit categories and pricing options be limited to just the Permit Fee, Plan Check Fee, and Issuance Fee. When the City conducted the 2021 User Fee Study, permits such as the Accessibility Permit and Energy Permit were added to help generate revenue. Department leads believe that the City has been brought up to industry standards, and the need for various categories is no longer needed. In addition, this approach will also assist the Building and Safety staff with calculating fees more quickly.

User Fees Subject to CPI Adjustment:

Since 2010, the City's user fees and charges continued to be adjusted and adopted annually by the prior year's change in the CPI for All Urban Consumers for the Los Angeles-Long Beach-Anaheim area. In 2025 the annual CPI increased by 3.3%. Table 1 below summarizes the annual CPI history reported by the Bureau of Labor Statistics and includes the date the City's CPI fee adjustment became effective, and the corresponding fiscal year.

A CPI adjustment to fees is a recommended best practice to ensure cost recovery keeps up with inflation. Furthermore, each year that transpires without modification of the rates to reflect the cost of doing business results in a loss of revenues that cannot be recovered retroactively and is therefore borne by the City's General Fund.

Staff has provided supplemental user fee schedules incorporating the 3.3% CPI increase. The schedule shows a side-by-side comparison and the potential changes to the fees if Council adopts the recommended user fees and the 3.3% CPI increase. These schedules are found in Attachment 1- Exhibit A.

It should be noted that not all user fees are recommended for CPI adjustment, this is due to fee limits per state mandates and local agreements with the County of Santa Barbara. The absences of these CPI adjustments are separate from any staff recommendations described above.

Public Notice Requirement

The user fees include both development and non-development fees. A public hearing is required for fee revisions. A public hearing notice was published in accordance with California Government Code section 6066 for a hearing at this April 15, 2025, regularly scheduled City Council meeting to adopt a resolution that confirms and updates the user fees and charges. The notice was published in the Santa Barbara Independent on April 3, 2025, and April 10, 2025. Additionally, it was made available for public review on the City's website.

Effective Date and Future Fee Updates

Staff is recommending an effective date of July 1, 2025, for all fees. This will enable staff sufficient time to update forms, applications, websites, and computer software as necessary for the fee updates.

The next annual user fee update is anticipated to be considered on March 17, 2026, to be effective for July 1, 2026, for FY 2026/27.

It is recommended best practice that a comprehensive review of the cost of services and fees be performed every three to five years. The next Comprehensive User Fee Study and Full Cost Allocation Plan Update is anticipated to begin in FY 2026/27 and be reviewed with Council in FY 2027/28.

Annual Fee Adjustment Issues

The CAP and User Fee Study were based on FY 2018/19 amended budgeted figures. Fees should be updated periodically to account for changes in costs and processes over time. The development and use of an annual fee increase mechanism normally provides a level of convenience and efficiency as staff does not have the time to recalculate cost recovery percentages on an annual basis and costs to have a consultant recalculate percentages can be prohibitive, yet the annual fee increase recovers some of the cost

increases. To ensure that the City receives appropriate fee increases that reflect the actual growth in cost, staff is recommending continued use of the current CPI factor which is the annual change in CPI of All Urban Consumers for the Los Angeles-Long Beach-Anaheim area, as produced by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. It should be noted that other inflationary factors can be employed. Since the primary factor for the cost of a city's service is usually driven by the costs of personnel involved, tying an inflationary factor that connects more directly to personnel costs can be suitable if there is a clear method or current practice of obtaining this type of factor. Staff will continue evaluating this in the future and will have future discussions with the Finance Committee.

Possible Fee Subsidies

It should be noted that the only fee subsidies considered were related to community center fees in establishing a commercial, non-profit, and private use rate when preparing this update. The following table summarizes previously adopted fee subsidies adopted by City Council action through prior adoption of fees or ordinances.

Fees associated with processing permits for businesses in the Old Town Heritage District were eliminated.	
The Old Town Business License Fee Waiver Program was initiated in March 2025, which will run for one year from the start date.	
There are also various exemptions of fees related to film permits per the Goleta Municipal Code Section 12.05.040, where the City issues permits for student films and non-profit organizations with fees waived upon proof of student or non-profit status and insurance.	

Note: While not included or part of the user fee and charges schedule, there are other fee subsidies and waivers related to development impact fees (DIFs) for beneficial projects approved by the City Council. On July 16, 2019, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 19-43, which established a list of Beneficial Projects that would be eligible for either a complete waiver of DIFs or a reduction in the required fees. On December 20, 2022, amended Resolution No. 19-43 by Resolution No. 22-68. Additional details can be found on the City's website.

The final suggested fee amounts were determined by each department, with most fees set at or near 100% full cost recovery.

There are no true policy-based subsidies on the fees being recommended, as the City does not have a formalized Cost Recovery Policy and Fee Establishment Policy specific to its user fees and charges. Staff have started this work effort and will be discussing the draft policy and framework further with the Finance Committee as a future item before the end of the fiscal year. This policy work will also address broader questions, including whether certain fee subsidies should be established for specific user groups (e.g., non-profit organizations involved in projects that generate a community benefit and were part of beneficial project types under the City's DIF waiver resolution, and also evaluating if certain fee levels might discourage compliance with regulatory requirements). The policies are anticipated to be adopted before engaging in its next major comprehensive user fee and cost allocation plan update, which is expected within the next two years.

It is important for the City and the public to understand that another revenue source, such as the General Fund, must cover subsidies. Therefore, the general taxpayer will potentially help to fund private benefits, and/or other City services will not receive funds that are otherwise directed to cover subsidies.

FINANCE COMMITTEE REVIEW:

The Finance Committee met to review the adjustments to the City's User Fees and Charges Schedule on April 7, 2025.

FISCAL IMPACTS:

Approving the updated recommended user fees and charges discussed above will allow the City to aim towards full cost recovery. Actual cost recovery is dependent upon actual activity in requests for those services.

It should be noted there are two fee types, including fixed or flat fees for services that do not vary greatly in staff time involved and deposit-based fees that allow for more precise accounting of costs on a project-by-project basis, which helps ensure nearly 100% full cost recovery.

The fees that are deposit-based start with an initial deposit amount and charges are made when activity occurs. Depending on the activity relative to the deposit fee, additional deposits may be requested to ensure adequate funds are collected before services are rendered. At the end of the service, any unused deposit amount would then be refunded to the applicant. Deposit-based fees are also the most staff time intensive as they require manual setup of accounts to track specific activity and user information, along with refunding or billing an applicant.

In service activities that do not vary greatly in time, staff recommends flat fees. All user fees and charges in the study are at or near full cost.

Overall revenue increases are difficult to estimate due to the change in activity levels from year to year. Currently, staff projects the impacts on the fees could result in an increase of \$10,000 to \$100,000. Primarily, adopting these updated fees would help ensure the City is pursuing full cost recovery.

ALTERNATIVES:

The City Council could take no action, thereby maintaining the current user fees and charges, resulting in specific fees not being charged and impacting the General Fund.

RESOLUTION NO 25-__

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
GOLETA, CALIFORNIA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION 24-23,
APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2025/2026
USER FEES AND CHARGES**

WHEREAS, the City of Goleta (the “City”) charges fees for various services, permits, licenses, and regulatory activity provided by the City (collectively, the “Fees”); and

WHEREAS, in order for the Fees to cover the costs of providing the services, permits, licenses, or regulatory activity for which the Fees are imposed, many of the Fees must be adjusted to reflect reasonable estimated costs of service; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to reclassify its Fees and repeal resolutions to accomplish this goal, and now wishes to readopt the Fees as set forth in Exhibit A, effective July 1, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously authorized the use of credit card for its customers to pay for City services; and

WHEREAS, there are certain transactional costs associated with the use of this payment method; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 6159, the City may impose a charge for the transactional costs associated with the use of such method; and

WHEREAS, such a charge or fee is subject to the procedures set forth in Government Code section 66018; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Government Code section 66018, the City Council called a public hearing for April 15, 2025, for the purpose of receiving public comments on the proposed fees. Notice of the public hearing was given by publication in a newspaper of general circulation within the City once a week for two weeks commencing at least 10 days prior to the public hearing, with at least 5 days intervening between the first and last publication. On April 15, 2025, at the time and place set for the public hearing, the City Council heard and considered all oral and written presentations and comments made regarding the proposed fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLETA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings.

The above Recitals are true and correct and by this reference incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. Adoption of User Fees.

The City Council hereby adopts the full City of Goleta Comprehensive User Fees and Charges Schedule described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The Fees imposed by this Resolution shall take effect on July 1, 2025 and are subject to a 3.30% CPI increase and supersede any prior fees or charges imposed by resolution or otherwise by the City Council, to the extent such prior fees or charges conflict herewith.

SECTION 3. Comprehensive Fee Resolution.

This resolution shall be known as the Comprehensive Fee Resolution.

SECTION 4. The City Council called a public hearing on April 15, 2025, for the purpose of receiving public comments to the proposed fees. Notice of the public hearing was given by publication in a newspaper of general circulation within the City once a week for two weeks commencing at least 10 days prior to the public hearing, with at least 5 days intervening between the first and last publication. On April 15, 2025, at the time and place set for the public hearing, the City Council heard and considered all oral and written presentations and comments made regarding the proposed fees.

SECTION 5: The City Council finds and determines that:

- (a) The Fees established by this resolution:
 - (1) are imposed for a specific government service provided directly to the payor, or for reasonable regulatory costs of the City for issuing licenses and permits, performing investigations, inspections, and administrative enforcement of the City's Municipal Code or other rules or ordinances.
 - (2) are no more than necessary to cover the reasonable costs of the governmental activity for which the Fee is imposed; and
 - (3) the manner in which those costs are allocated to a payor bear a fair or reasonable relationship to the payor's burdens on, or benefits received from, the governmental activity for which the Fee is imposed; and
- (b) The Fees are not taxes within the meaning of California Constitution article XIII C, section 1(e).

SECTION 6. If any section, subsection, clause or phrase in this resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is for any reason held invalid, the validity of the remainder of this resolution or the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases or the application thereof to any person or circumstance be held invalid.

SECTION 7. Should the City accept payment of any fee identified in Exhibit A of this Resolution, as it may be amended from time to time, by means of credit card in lieu of check or cash, the City shall impose a separate fee equal to three percent (3%) or actual cost charged to the City of the transaction amount as a convenience fee for processing the payment. The City Council finds and determines that accessibility to the library, along with parks and recreation programs, benefit the community and serve a public purpose. Accordingly, a credit card convenience fee shall not be charged for library or parks and recreation related fees. In no event shall the convenience fee exceed the actual transactional costs incurred by the City in providing for the payment by credit card. When the City accepts payment by means of credit card, it shall also accept payment by means of check or cash.

SECTION 8. The City Manager and Director of Finance are hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to implement and collect the Fees and the credit card convenience fee.

SECTION 9. Resolutions 24-23 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 10. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

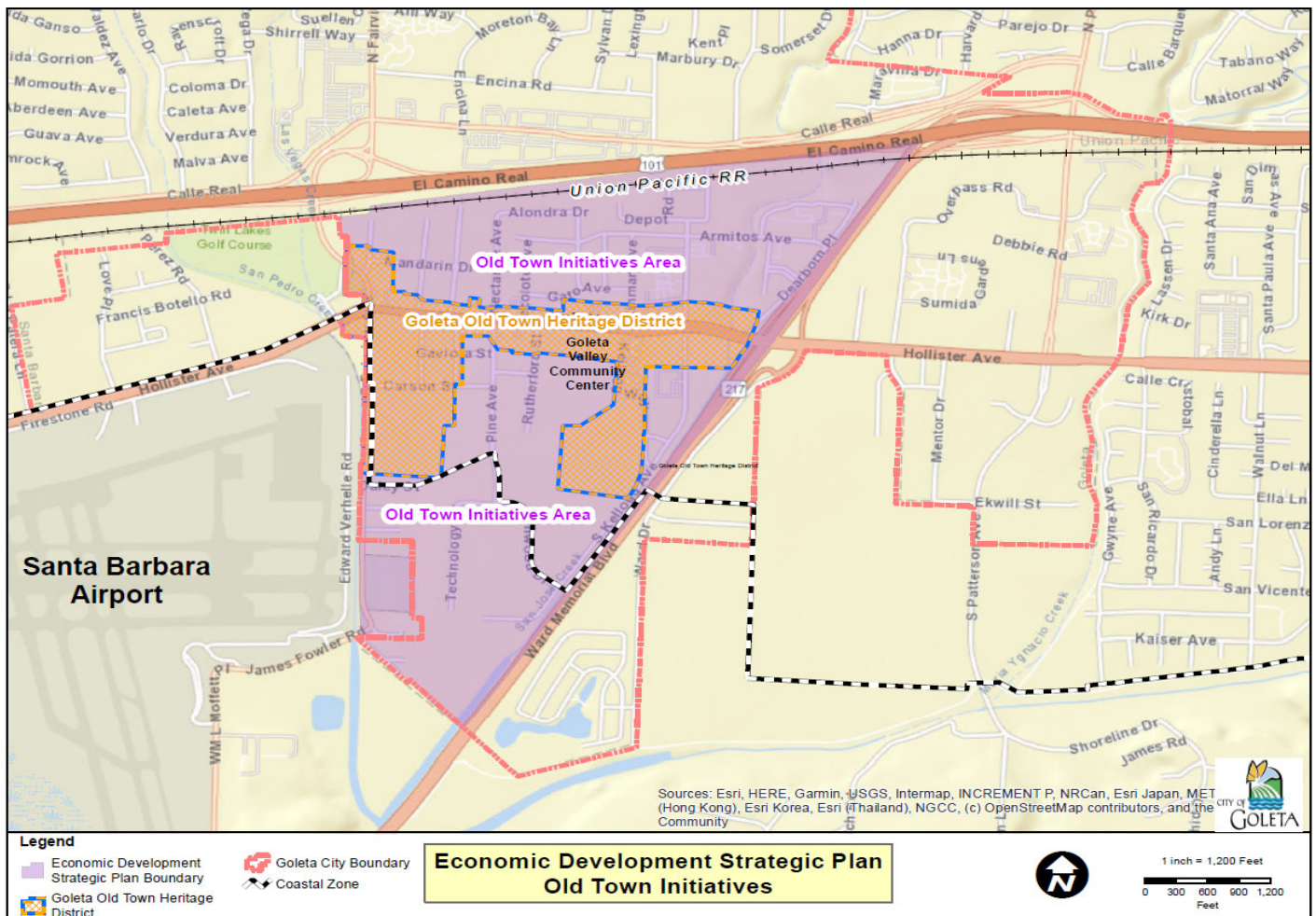

User Fees Background

- User Fees are charges for services and regulatory fees – planning services, permit fees, library fees, business licenses
- Based on Cost Allocation Plan (CAP) and User Fee Study conducted by Willdan Financial Services presented on April 20, 2021, which took effect FY 21/22
- Fees should recover costs
- State law precludes charging more than the cost of providing service
- Public Hearing required with revision to its fees

A public notice was published for this hearing in the Santa Barbara Independent on April 3, 2025, and April 10, 2025 .

Proposed User Fees Updates

- **Recommending CPI increase of 3.3% effective July 1, 2025**
- **Recommending new fees and updates that include description changes, price corrections:**
 - Finance and Administration Fees
 - Business License – Massage Certification Price Reduction
 - Short-Term Vacation License Appeal Fee
 - Listing Penalties associated with Licenses & Taxes
 - Neighborhood Services
 - No CPI for Park Related items
