



Latest Projects and Partnerships

- Santa Barbara Film Festival partnership Provide seniors who are transit dependent access to private film screenings at the Riviera Theater.
- Dial-a-Ride Direct pilot project- Provides enhanced support to Easy Lift passengers who have an unforeseen same day transportation needs to lifeline services such as medical appointments, prescription pickups and nutrition sites.
- Central Coast Collaborative on Homelessness partnership Provides the displaced community warming shelter and nutrition during cold and rainy days. 115 women and men were served in the last 8 shelter activation days.
