#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The City of Goleta has provided funding for the Santa Barbara Unified School District in the amount of \$13,000 since FY 2010-11 to support after-school sports activities at Goleta Valley Junior High School. Prior to the school district taking over the management of the program, funding was granted to and managed by the Santa Barbara Police Activities League.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

Goleta Valley Junior High school Principal, Mauricio Ortega, will provide a brief presentation on the programming offered to the Goleta youth through its after-school sports program and the many benefits it provides. The programs includes a wide range of sports for girls and boys provided for a five week season, running from late September to early May.
