Commissioner Miller recused himself because of the 500-foot rule; and also because he is president of The Hideaway Homeowners Association (HOA) and has been involved in presenting the view of the HOA during the project. Commissioner Miller exited the dais and seated himself in the audience.

Site visits and ex-parte conversations. Vice Chair Smith reported she drove by the site today. Vice Chair Smith reported that she exchanged emails today with staff and that all information in the emails has been addressed in today's hearing; and also she spoke with Robert Miller, president of The Hideaway HOA. Chair Fuller and Commissioner Linn each reported no ex-parte conversations.

Vyto Adomaitis, Neighborhood Services & Public Safety Director, introduced the Fire Station 10 Project and presented the background and history. The Staff Report was presented by Laura Bridley, Contract Planner, who reviewed the application request and highlights of the staff report with a PowerPoint presentation. The Project architect, Todd Jespersen, with Kruger, Bensen, Ziemer (KBZ) Architects, presented the project with a PowerPoint presentation emphasizing site, architectural and landscape design elements of the project. The separate Powerpoint presentations were both entitled "Fire Station 10, Case No. 17-069-GPA-RZ-DP, 16-044-DRB, Planning Commission Hearing, October 8, 2018, Dept. of Neighborhood Services & Public Safety". Staff presented an "Errata to the Fire Station 10 Final Environmental Impact Report Dated September 2018, SCH#2017081066 for Cases 17-069-GPA-RZ-DP".

Staff and members of the project team responded to questions from the Planning Commission. The project team includes Fire Department Division Chief Martin Johnson; Fire Department Captain Michael Klusyk; Robert Schmidt, Flowers & Associates, project civil engineer; David Stone,

contract environmental consultant with Amec Foster Wheeler; and Laurel Brady, Earthform Design, project landscape architect.

Chair Fuller opened the Public Hearing for public comments at 6:45 p.m.

Staff and the project team members responded to questions from the Planning Commission.

Commissioner Maynard requested staff clarify and correct the tree count from 39 to 33 in the Final Environmental Impact Report, which seems inconsistent with the current landscape plan, in the EIR sections and page numbers that she read into the record: pp 2-25, 2-26, 7-30, 7-31, 7-36, 7-37, 7-45, 7-50, 7-53, and 7-60. Staff responded that these corrections will be captured in a revised Errata sheet before the City Council hearing. Commissioner Maynard also requested that the Coastal Commission and those persons who submitted the comment letters be notified of this correction prior to the City Council public hearing.

Chair Fuller closed the Public Hearing for public comment at 7:18 p.m.

The Planning Commission deliberated on the information presented during the public hearing and provided input which is recorded in the video of the meeting.
