RECOMMENDATION

- ❖ Receive information on a possible mural to be placed on the west side of the handball wall at Jonny D. Wallis Neighborhood Park and provide a recommendation to City Council; or
- ❖ Take no action, retaining the wall as colored stucco with no additions.



BACKGROUND

- ❖ The park is under construction and on schedule to open in March of 2019.
- ❖ The handball wall is 16 feet high and 20 feet wide, has a colored stucco finish and can be seen from the street and adjacent properties.



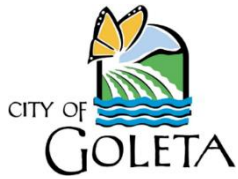
DISCUSSION POINTS

- ❖ Original design included two trees against the blank wall, using the colored stucco as a nice backdrop.
- ❖ A message board for posting meeting and events in the City will be placed at the base of the wall, instead of the proposed trees.
- ❖ The top portion of the wall remains available for consideration of a potential mural.



THE COMMISSION'S ROLE

- ❖ Consider and discuss options for the upper portion of the backside of the handball wall.
- ❖ If the Commission would like to consider anything other than leaving it as stucco, a recommendation would need to be carried forward to City Council by staff for further consideration.



FISCAL IMPACTS

- ❖ While there are no fiscal impacts associated with the discussion, the addition of a mural for this area could cost between \$5,000 - \$25,000 for development and installation.
- ❖ Annual maintenance and replacement costs would also factor into fiscal impacts, which could vary based on the type of materials used.
