SUBJECT: Planning Commission Appointments

RECOMMENDATION:

A. Conduct candidate interviews for the Planning Commission; and

B. Continue this item to the February 19, 2019 City Council Meeting for ratification of three mayoral appointments to the Planning Commission.

BACKGROUND:

The Planning Commission is authorized by Goleta Municipal Code Section 2.09.010. The Planning Commission consists of five members, each of whom must be a resident of the City of Goleta and a qualified elector within the City. The term of office for each Commissioner is four years and is set to expire at the first regular meeting of the February following the expiration of the current term of office of the City Councilmember who appointed the Commission Member.

In the past, each City Councilmember was required to appoint one member to the Planning Commission. However, now that the City has a directly-elected mayor, appointments to all City boards and commissions, including the Planning Commission, must be made by the Mayor and ratified by the City Council. Mayor Perotte, Councilmember Aceves and Councilmember Kyriaco each assumed office for a new term in December 2018, and accordingly, now have the opportunity to nominate candidates for appointment to the Planning Commission.

DISCUSSION:

In anticipation of the expiring Planning Commission terms, the City Clerk's office published requests for candidate applications on the City website, the Monarch Press, Channel 19, the local adjudicated newspaper, Facebook, Nextdoor, GovDelivery Bulletins, Twitter, and posted at various locations throughout the City.

Edward Fuller and Katie Maynard have expressed interest in continuing to serve on the Planning Commission. The City received an additional seven applications for the Planning Commission from Sara Iza, Dennis Lowrey, Fermina Murray, Daalia Reynolds,

Bill Shelor, Alfred Smith, and B. Grace Wallis. Staff has confirmed interview times for these applicants.

This agenda item allows the City Council the opportunity to conduct interviews and for Mayor Perotte, and Councilmembers Aceves and Kyriaco to nominate candidates for the mayoral appointment. Ratification of the Mayor's appointments will come before the City Council on February 19, 2019. The table below lists the candidates and their interview scheduled times.

FISCAL IMPACTS:

There is no direct fiscal impact associated with interviewing candidates for the Planning Commission, other than the staff time needed to prepare for and assist with the interviews.

However, delaying interviews would impact the appointment of three members of the Planning Commission, and could cause delays in the New Zoning Ordinance review process.
