**SUBJECT:** Ratification of Four Mayoral Appointments to the Parks and Recreation Commission

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Ratify the mayoral appointments of Megan Peterson, Wayne Rascati, Daryl West and Deborah Williams to the Parks and Recreation Commission.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Parks and Recreation Commission is authorized by Goleta Municipal Code Section 2.12.020. The Parks and Recreation Commission consists of five members, one of which shall be a student 15 years or older, each of whom must be a resident of the City of Goleta. The term of office for each commissioner is four years, the student commissioner serves one-year term.

Now that the City has a directly-elected Mayor, appointments to all City boards and commissions, including the Parks and Recreation Commission, must be made by the Mayor and ratified by the City Council.

On February 21, 2019, the City Council held a special meeting to conduct interviews of all applicants for the Parks and Recreation Commission and to nominate candidates for the mayoral appointment. Respectively, the City Council have nominated Megan Peterson, Wayne Rascati, Daryl West and Deborah Williams to the Commission. Three of the terms will expire in February 2023. The fourth term will expire on February 2021; this was due to the resignation of Kathleen Werner, whose term was set to expire at that time.

**DISCUSSION:**

This agenda item allows the City Council the opportunity to ratify the Mayor's appointments to the Parks and Recreation Commission. As a result of the nominations received on February 21, 2019 at the conclusion of the Special City Council Meeting, Mayor Perotte has appointed Megan Peterson, Wayne Rascati, Daryl West and Deborah Williams to the Parks and Recreation Commission, and now seeks Council's ratification of these appointments.

**FISCAL IMPACTS:**


There is no direct fiscal impact associated with ratifying the Mayor's appointees to the Parks and Recreation Commission, other than the staff time needed to prepare this report.
