











## LIMIT SEARCH BY OWNING LIBRARY






### LIMIT SEARCH BY MATERIAL TYPE







## SUGGEST A PURCHASE

- ❖ If Goleta Valley Library does not own an item that you want, fill out the online Suggest a Purchase form.
- If the Collection Development team opts to purchase the item for the collection, you will be notified so that you can place a hold request on the item when it appears in the Black Gold catalog.
- We take suggestions for books, DVDs, Books on CD and music CDs.

## ZIP BOOKS PROGRAM

- Funded by the California State Library
- If no one owns the book, large print book or book on cd, the item is eligible for the Zip program.
- If book, large print book or book on cd was published more than 2 years prior and costs less than a state-set maximum, we will order it.
- The GVL will order the item from Amazon and have it sent directly to your home. You can keep it as long as you need to and then bring it to the Library when you are finished with it.
- Apply via the online Suggest a Purchase form.



## LIBRARY OF THINGS

- New collection of non-traditional, 3-D items.
- Includes: a record player, robots and coding games for kids, portable projector, cake pans, games and much more.
- Must be borrowed from and returned to the Goleta Valley Library.
