RECOMMENDATION:

Receive a presentation from the Santa Barbara Unified School District on the Goleta Valley Junior High School After School Sports Program.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Goleta has provided funding for the Santa Barbara Unified School District (SBUSD) in the amount of \$13,000 since FY 2010-11 to support after-school sports activities at Goleta Valley Junior High School. Prior to the school district managing the program, funding was granted to and managed by the Santa Barbara Police Activities League. For the current 2018-19 Fiscal Year, funding to SBUSD was provided through the City Council's Support to Other Agencies budget (101-5-1100-223).

DISCUSSION:

Goleta Valley Junior High School Principal, Mauricio Ortega, will provide a presentation on the programming offered to Goleta youth through its after-school sports program and the many benefits it provides. The program includes a wide range of sports and other enrichment activities for girls and boys during a five-week season, running from late September to early May.
