Background & Process

- Library Special Tax created 1990
- County Service Area 3 approved Measure L to fund services, operations and maintenance at the Goleta Library
- City assumed ownership in 2002, upon incorporation
- Annual Adjustment Consumer Price Index (CPI): 3.8%
- Notice of Public Hearing
 - June 27, 2019 & July 3, 2019
- ▶ June 18th Agreement to Place Direct Charges on the 2019/20 Tax Bills
- Resolution
 - Establish the new tax rates with the CPI increase for FY 2019/20.

CPI Adjustment

- Consumer Price Index (CPI) adjustment: 3.8%
- Parcel count based on FY 19/20 tax roll.
