Most of the statistics collected for this report are newly collected and therefore not available for the years preceding. This report sets a baseline for the future.

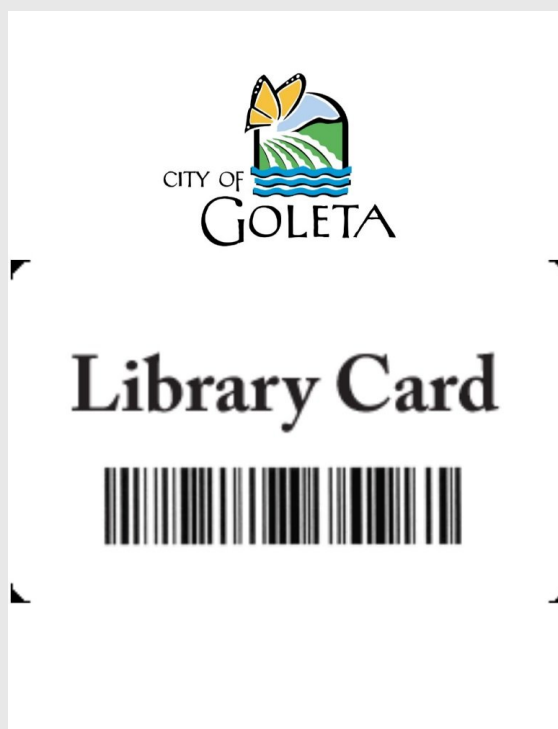

FISCAL YEAR 2018/2019

The Goleta Valley Library Service Population is 95,202.
At the end of June 2019, there were 10,103 registered library
card holders.



The operating expenditures for FY18/19 were \$1,464,164

The Library was open 55 hours each week

The total open hours for the year was 15,437

261,316 people visited the Library during that time



10.88 FTE Staff members helped the more than a quarter of a million visitors fulfill their library needs



Library staff answered 21,736 reference questions



At the end of June 2019, the GVL held 116,315 physical volumes

6,472 audiovisual items were owned

13,725 DVD's were in the collection



The total physical item circulation for FY 18/19 was
605,935!

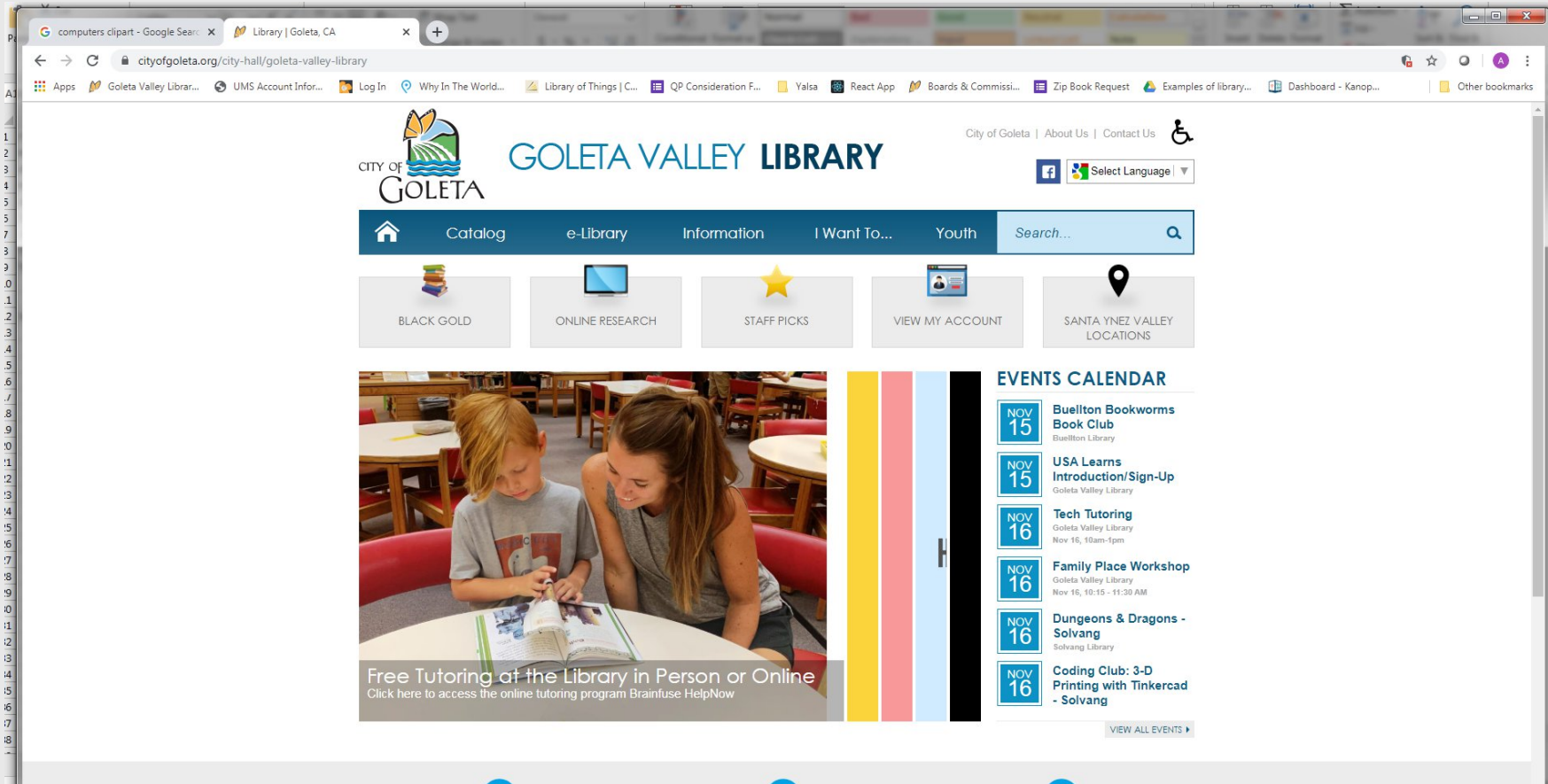
