We are a regional private park for public use serving the Goleta Community and our local neighborhood with 500,000 visits annually.

Original 12 Acre Park opened in 1999

Built in conjunction with Camino Real Marketplace

2001: Purchased an additional the 13 acres to the west named Elings Fields for \$6,000,000 after a successful Fields Forever Campaign.


2008: Opened Girsh-Hochman Soccer Field after raising \$1,250,000 in our Fields Forever 2 Capital Campaign.

2018: Completed the \$750,000 Fields Forever 3 Capital Campaign that built Marborg Industries Fieldhouse that includes a concession stand and restrooms, ADA access to the facility, a new playground, and new batting cages.

Girsh-Hochman Field: \$1,250,000 project opened in 2008 Used seven days a week by youth and adult soccer programs, tournaments, and camps





Broke ground on the new fieldhouse building in April 2015





We have completed restrooms, storage, drainage improvements and ADA access to the facility. This is a \$600,000 facility upgrade


















Current Project: Replace temporary generator light system With permanent field lighting on Girsh Hochman Field
