STATISTICS

- Circulated 49,186 items in January
- Decrease of 1.6% from last January
- 24,638 visited in January
- ❖ 5,816 borrowed items from other libraries
- GVL loaned 4,561 to patrons from other libraries
- One outreach event was conducted with a total of 55 contacts
- ❖ 70 programs conducted at the Library with attendance of 1,733

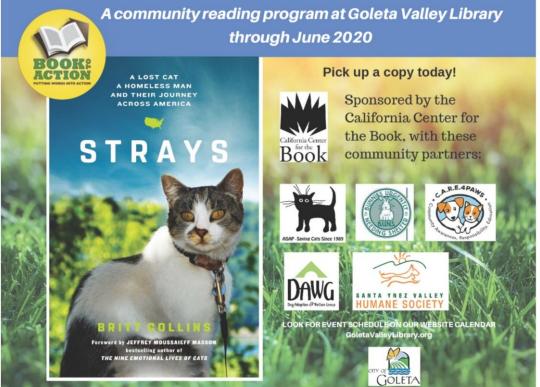




GRANTSBook to Action

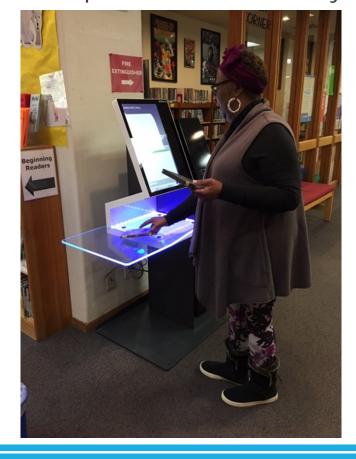

❖I attended the Annual Friends Meeting and thanked them for their extremely generous support in this past year.



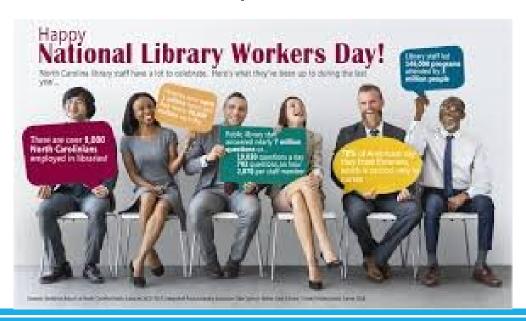


HARWOOD
