**SUBJECT:** Report on Annual Adjustments for User Fees and Charges

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

A. Conduct a Public Hearing on the Proposed User Fees and Charges.

B. Adopt Resolution No. 20-\_\_ entitled "A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Goleta, California, Rescinding Resolution 19-33, Approving and Adopting the 2020 User Fees and Charges."

#### **BACKGROUND:**

On November 18, 2008, the City Council adopted Resolution 08-62 adopting the 2008 User Fees and Charges, which took effect on December 1, 2008. That resolution subjected the adopted User Fees and Charges to annual modification based on the prior year change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for All Urban Consumers for the Los Angeles-Long Beach-Riverside area. On March 16, 2010 the City Council set a minimum threshold of 3% CPI change for consideration of adjustments to User Fees and Charges. The intent of the March 16, 2010 action by Council was to minimize small adjustments, thereby setting the "floor" for future adjustments to occur only when the cumulative CPI increase was at or above 3%. On April 21, 2015, Council took action to eliminate fees associated with processing sign permits for businesses located in the Old Town Heritage District, effective July 1, 2015. On May 15, 2018 Council action was taken to annually consider CPI adjustments, eliminating the previous process of using a 3% cumulative threshold "floor". User Fees were last adjusted by 3.8% on June 4, 2019, effective July 1, 2019.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

User fees are charges for services, such as planning related services or services related to other City regulatory permits such as City business licenses, whereby those receiving the services from the City are required to pay the costs rather than burdening the residents. State law precludes charging more than the cost of providing the service. The current Master User Fees and Charges are based on a cost analysis performed by

Willdan Finance Services and finalized in November 2008. Since then, various new fees have been included to reflect new licenses, permits, library fees, and applicable fees have been adjusted by CPI annually.

#### **Process of Updating City User Fees and Charges:**

Any update to the City's Master User Fees and Charges requires a public hearing to allow City Council to receive public input. A public hearing notice was published in accordance with California Government Code section 6066 for a hearing at this March 17, 2020 regularly scheduled City Council meeting to adopt a resolution that confirms the user fee and charges schedule. The proposed resolution creates (1) new fees for permit types established or changed as a result of the NZO, which would be effective on May 16, 2020 and (2) subjects all fees to a CPI increase of 3.1% which would be effective on July 1, 2020. The notice was published in the Santa Barbara Independent on March 5, 2020 and March 12, 2020.

Please note that the recommended rates are rounded to the nearest whole dollar, with the exception of rates that are currently in cents. In addition, for clarity of the recommended change in rates and new fees, Exhibit A displays a column with the current rates and recommended rates with effective dates. This column with the current rates will not be a part of the permanent Exhibit to the adopting resolution, or a part of the User Fees and Charges schedule that will be posted to the City's website. Should the proposed rates be approved, the recommended new fees will be effective May 16, 2020 and the CPI adjustment will be effective July 1, 2020 to coincide with the City's fiscal year.

#### Proposed Updates to the City's Master User Fees and Charges Schedule

The following section describes the recommended new fees to be effective May 16, 2020 and fees subject to CPI adjustment to be effective July 1, 2020 to coincide with the new budget fiscal year. Given that the New Zoning Ordinance will be effective this fiscal year, the earliest effective date for fees that are development-related is 60 days following adoption of the fee. In an effort to control administrative costs, staff is recommending all of the new fees be effective on the May 16, 2020 date.

#### Planning and Environmental Review User Fees:

The adoption of the New Zoning Ordinance (NZO) (GMC Title 17) has resulted in one new fee and several amendments to current fees in the Master User Fees and Charges Schedule. The new fee is a Zoning Code Determination fee. Additionally, the updated Schedule includes a variety of changes to reflect changes in permit and approval types and terminology in the NZO. These changes alter only one fee associated with Non-Exempt Accessory Dwelling Units, which was previously being charged under Accessory Structures and should be a separate fixed fee due to the specific application process. The updated Schedule also removes several fees that are not included in the NZO. The amendments to the Schedule also include renaming the current Zoning Conformity Determination fee to Cannabis Business License Letter for clarity, with no

fee change. In discussions with Planning and Environmental Review staff, the Zoning Code Determination fee is recommended to be deposit based, due to the range of work and complexity involved for the fee type. Staff recommends setting the initial deposit amount at \$1,200, which is based on an estimated average of six hours at the blended fully burdened hourly rate for Planning staff. Since this is an initial deposit, any unused amounts will be refunded to the applicant. The Non-Exempt Accessory Dwelling Unit fee is a fixed fee starting at \$1,100, which is based on five hours at the blended fully burdened hourly rate for Planning staff. The fees are recommended to be effective May 16, 2020.

#### Public Works User Fees:

City staff has identified other user fees and charges that should be included in the current fee schedule. The fee types are currently charged in Public Works but have not been formally adopted. These fees include an Amtrak Bike Locker Key Deposit for \$25 (non-refundable if lost) and Commemorative Bench Deposit of \$1,600. Since these fee types are initial deposits, any unused amounts will be refunded to the applicant. These fees are recommended to be effective May 16, 2020.

#### Time and Material Rates:

City staff recommends including a section specific to time and material rates as they relate to use of city personnel and materials purchased or consultants utilized. Including this section increases transparency of staff time charges, material fees or use of consultants that may not be listed in the user fee and charges schedule. In the event that someone requests work from staff that does not have an associated fee, the City will request a deposit amount to cover the estimated fully burdened staff costs, direct material costs, if any, and a 15% citywide overhead rate, if applicable. Since the time and material fee type will be an initial deposit, any unused amounts would be refunded to the applicant. The initial deposit amount may be established by the Department Director for the type of service it relates to. An example of this is if a person disputes a fee and requests an audit. Pursuant to California Government Code Section 66023, any person who disputes a fee can request that the City conduct an audit to determine whether the fee levied exceeds the amount reasonably necessary to cover the costs. The requester must deposit with the City the estimated cost of the audit. At the conclusion of the audit, the City will reimburse unused sums, if any, or the requester will pay the City the excess of the actual cost of the audit over the sum of the deposit. These fees are recommended to be effective May 16, 2020.

#### User Fees Subject to CPI Adjustment:

In 2019 the annual CPI increased by 3.1%. Table 1 below summarizes the annual CPI history reported by the Bureau of Labor Statistics and includes the date the City's CPI fee adjustment became effective, and the corresponding fiscal year.

<sup>\*</sup>CPI adjustment made cumulative as soon as it passed 3%. On May 15, 2018, City Council took action to consider annual CPI adjustment going forward.

A CPI adjustment to fees is a recommended best practice to ensure cost recovery keeps up with inflation. Furthermore, each year that transpires without modification of the rates to reflect the cost of doing business reflects a loss of revenues that cannot be recovered retroactively and is therefore borne by the City's General Fund.

Staff has provided a modification of the existing User Fees and Charges to reflect the inflationary increase as presented in Exhibit A of the attached resolution in addition to recommending new user fees and other updates. The schedule shows a side-by-side comparison and the potential changes if Council adopts the recommended new user fees and the 3.1% CPI increase.

It should be noted that not all user fees are recommended for CPI adjustment. This is due to fee limits per state mandates, maintaining consistency with local library fees in the region, and other City fees that are fixed by ordinance and/or resolution specific to that fee type. Those fees are primarily related to business licenses and specialty licenses and include General Business License, Firearm, Massage, Taxicab, Tobacco Retail and Short-Term Vacation Rental Permit Fee, and will require an amendment to those ordinances to reference the Master User Fees and Charges. Following completion of the comprehensive user fee study that staff is undertaking, explained more fully below, staff plans to bring recommended amendments to these fees to Council for consideration.

#### Comprehensive User Fee Study and Full Cost Allocation Plan Update

On January 16, 2018 Council awarded a contract to Willdan Financial Services for a Comprehensive User Fee Study and Full Cost Allocation Plan. It has been eleven years since the last study was conducted. An updated fee study will provide the City the opportunity to reevaluate all user fees, including Library fees, as they relate to Council policy, staff time and the related cost to provide the service. Once the study is complete, Council will have the opportunity to adopt the fees at full cost recovery or less than full cost recovery for some or all fees. The project is broken into two phases, requiring the development of a Full Cost Allocation Plan first, and then using the results of the Full

Cost Allocation Plan to develop the Comprehensive User Fee Study. The draft Full Cost Allocation Plan was completed in October 2018. Since then, there have been various delays in completing the Comprehensive User Fee Study, though it is now near completion. Staff is in the process of consolidating all user fees into one document, including building and safety related fees, which have previously never been part of the City's Master User Fees and Charges Schedule. The compiling of the results of the fee study is also currently underway. Staff anticipates the study to be completed by June and reviewed with the Finance Committee in early FY 2020/21.

#### FINANCE COMMITTEE REVIEW:

The Finance Committee met to review the adjustments to the Master User Fees and Charges schedule on March 10, 2020.

#### FISCAL IMPACTS:

These costs are borne by the City and in order to recover the cost to provide these services, staff recommends the City Council adopt the recommended Master User Fees and Charges Schedule. If the City Council adopts the recommended Master User Fees and Charges Schedule, staff will be able to charge the deposit-based fees that pertain to the New Zoning Ordinance and provide further transparency of other fees being charged effective May 16, 2020. The recommended 3.1% increase to the applicable user fees and charges may result in an additional revenue of approximately \$10,000 to the General Fund annually starting in FY 20/21. Actual revenues related to user fees and charges are dependent on activity in requests for those services.

#### ALTERNATIVES:

The City Council could take no action, thereby maintaining the current User Fees and Charges, which may result in certain fees not being charged and impact the General Fund. Alternatively, Council could direct staff to modify User Fees and Charges by a percentage other than the linked CPI change.

#### **RESOLUTION NO 20-**

# A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLETA, CALIFORNIA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION 19-33, APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE 2020 USER FEES AND CHARGES

**WHEREAS,** California Government Code Sections 66000 et seq authorizes the imposition of various user fees for providing City services and reviewing entitlement applications; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council on March 17, 2020 conducted a Public Hearing on the proposed User Fees, wherein the Council considered the addition of the proposed new deposit related fees and Consumer Price Index data supporting the modification of the fees; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to rescind Resolution 19-33 and adopt a new resolution to adopt the proposed User Fees and Charges schedule; and

**WHEREAS**, the User Fees and Charges attached as Exhibit A are justified and appropriate, not exceeding the value of the services provided therefore.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLETA FINDS AND DETERMINES AS FOLLOWS:

#### <u>SECTION 1</u>. Findings.

Council finds recitals to be true and accurate and incorporates them by this reference.

#### **SECTION 2**. Rescission.

Council rescinds Resolution 19-33.

#### **SECTION 3. Adoption of User Fees.**

User Fees and Charges, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, are hereby adopted and are effective on May 16, 2020 and are subject to a 3.1% CPI increase effective July 1, 2020 as identified in Exhibit A and supersedes any and all prior user fees and changes that are inconsistent with Exhibit A.

#### **SECTION 4. Master Fee Resolution.**

This resolution shall be known as the Master Fee Resolution.

**SECTION 5**. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

# User Fees Background

## **User Fees are Charges for Services**

- Paid by those receiving the service rather than burdening the residents
- Examples include: Planning services, permit fees, library fees
- State law precludes charging more than cost of providing service
- Based on a fee study performed by Willdan Finance Service and implemented December 1, 2008
- Last CPI adjustment was 3.8%, effective July 1, 2019.

# User Fees - Updates

- Public hearing notice published March 5 and March 12, 2020 (SB Independent)
- Proposed Updates:
  - Recommending new fees to be effective May 16, 2020
    - Planning and Environmental Review User Fees
    - Public Works User Fees
    - Time and Material Rates
  - Recommending CPI increase of 3.1% effective July 1, 2020
    - Does not include certain fee types established by ordinance or library fees
