We are writing requesting your support and approval of **Consent Calendar Agenda item A.1 (20-112)**. Our community has lived (and in at least 1 case died) for years

with this dangerous crosswalk (Calle Real and Kingston). In 2016, then City of Goleta Traffic Engineer Heba El-Guendy, secured State Highway Safety funds to improve safety at the Calle Real and Kingston intersection with a HAWK (PHB – Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons) light controlled crosswalk like the one in front of the Goleta Community Center. NTGS (New Town Goleta Safety) and COAST (Coalition for Sustainable Transportation – through Safe Routes For Seniors) have worked hard for over **8 years** to secure support from City Council to address this serious safety issue. Public Works is now on the threshold of securing your support for the completed design and commencement of the job bidding process. **Please do not let us down. Please approve this project so that it can be completed on schedule this summer (2020).**

Dear Councilmember Kasdin:

I strongly support pedestrian safety improvements at Chapel Street and Hollister Avenue and Kingston Avenue and Calle Real intersections.

The proposal for the PHB at Kingston and Calle Real, which is five car lanes and two bike lanes wide with a 35 mph speed limit, includes an overhead signal which is appropriate for that intersection. My wife and I often walk this area and are aware that this would be an important improvement for pedestrian safety

However, the proposal and plans for the RRFB at Chapel and Hollister do not mention an overhead signal. Hollister Avenue is also five car lanes and two bike lanes wide at Chapel Street. But the speed limit there is 10 mph higher at 45 mph.

With such a wide street and faster traffic, it would be important to have overhead signals in addition to street level signals for this intersection as well. This would increase drivers' awareness when the signal is activated and allow them to properly and safely come to a stop.

I am requesting that the Council adds overhead signaling for the Chapel Street and Hollister Avenue intersection.

Thank you for for the City's efforts to keep pedestrians safe and for your continuing work on behalf of our community during the pandemic.
