

Project Background:

- Started back in 2015. Significant public outreach / City Council meetings.
- \$2.2M Active Transportation Program grant.
- Awarded on December 17, 2019 to Toro Enterprise.
- Started Construction on March 2, 2020.
 - 3 Zones and 5 Phases.
- Resident coordination, ROW, parking issues, work area constraints, COVID-19, & significant utility coordination.

9031 Old Town Sidewalk Improvement Project - Construction Update

Construction Status:

- Substantial completion mid-Sept. 2020.
 - Pending completion of utility work.
- Construction \$3.16M, CCOs \$230k (est.).
 - CCO authority = \$632k.
 - Roadway subgrade issues and utility work/delays.
- Minimal complaints & positive feedback.
- Ahead of schedule and underbudget.
- Kudos to Project Team!
