SUBJECT: Interviews of the Parks and Recreation Commission

RECOMMENDATION:

A. Conduct candidate interviews for the Parks and Recreation Commission; and

B. Select two Parks and Recreation Commissioners: one to fulfill the remainder of a term ending February 1, 2021 and one Student Commissioner with a term ending October 6, 2021.

BACKGROUND:

The Parks and Recreation Commission is a seven-member body with responsibility to provide citizens a platform to discuss the needs, opportunities and current offerings of parks and recreation activities in the City. Each Parks and Recreation commissioner is appointed by the City Council on an at large basis.

On July 31, 2020, Anthony Ramos submitted his resignation from the Parks and Recreation Commission. Nora Kelly (Student Member) also notified staff that she would not be reapplying to the Parks and Recreation Commission. Accordingly, there is an opportunity for two commissioners to be appointed by the Mayor (one regular member and one student member).

DISCUSSION:

Staff published requests for candidate applications on the City website, in the Monarch Press, on Channel 19, in the local adjudicated newspaper, on Facebook, in GovDelivery Bulletins, on Twitter, and through postings at various locations throughout the City.

The City Clerk's office received applications from Victor Birtalan, C Edward Holdren, Lee Ann Palmer, Steve Greig, Danny Azar, Gareth Kelly, Lesa Mann, La Risa Chambers, Victoria Ballmes, Hopi Mundell and Scott Kornahrens for the regular Parks and Recreation Commission vacancy.

The City Clerk's office also received applications from Kyle Yao, Logan Bryce, Thomas Radjuko, and Jonika Ronkainen for the student Parks and Recreation Commission vacancy.

Staff has confirmed interview times for these applicants.
