

COMMUNITY GARDEN - 9084

- Staff has reviewed the 35% construction documents and provided feedback to the designer
- Draft procedures reviewed by the Parks and Recreation Commission
- Still awaiting word on Urban Greening Grant Program





MISCELLANEOUS PARK IMPROVEMENTS - 9066 & 9108

Authorization from City Council to go out to bid is scheduled for later this month

Projects address ADA concerns, expands and/or replaces playgrounds at three locations and installation of fitness equipment at the fourth location in Goleta.





SPLASH PAD & IMPROVEMENTS - 9111

The recommendation from the Parks and Recreation Commission related to the design of the splash pad is tentatively scheduled to go before the City Council on October 20th.
