Michelle Greene, City Manager, noted a workshop and outreach process would begin for a Prop 68 grant being targeted by the Girsh Park Foundation. Ms. Greene congratulated the City of Goleta for a 76% response rate on the 2020 Census which is highest in Santa Barbara County, and thanked Kelly Hoover, PIO/Community Relations Manager and Jaime Shaw, Management Assistant for their work with the 2020 Census. Ms. Greene announced a Creek and Watershed Management Plan workshop will be held on November 2, 2020, at 7:00 P.M.
