Please pull the Item A2 "Amendments to Service Agreements for Janitorial Services and Landscape Maintenance at Parks and Open Spaces" from the Consent Calendar to make the corrections below and read the attached comments into the record as I cannot be there in person.

Agreement No. 2017-040.

On page 1 under recommendation B we see a **new total of** \$439,200. On page 96 it states the total compensation **SHALL NOT EXCEED** the sum of \$329,400. Which is the correct sum?

**Page 66** At least five trees have been lost in Winchester II Open Space and the **picture shown** is NOT how the Open Space looks today. The picture provided is most likely old and from **before** the trees where lost.

**Page 71** Green Parks Inventory Updated 4-21-14 Under Features: Winchester II Open Space is missing in bold letters **1 trash can, 1 dog station.** These elements have been here for years and the list needs to reflect that.

Why is it that the monthly costs for services to Winchester II Open Space reflects the lowest amount of all the listings?

I have already shared what the Safety Data Sheet states about the products planned for use in Winchester II Open Space.

Under precautionary statement for Product at Use Dilution it states: "Keep away from children. Avoid direct contact with product.

The EPA Registered Label Information in the Safety Data Sheet on page 10 states:" Danger. Keep out of reach of children. Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns." How is the City of Goleta addressing the community right to know laws?

There is also Acute Aquatic toxicity. And it is stated to avoid release into the environment.
