STATISTICS

Circulated 12,623 items in October; this is down 75% from last October, as is to be expected.

1,656 Craft Kits have been dispersed since July 1.



ISLA VISTA GRANT

✓ Letters went out to all IV agencies, UCSB, housing units, schools to announce the Bookvan's presence next year and assess who will want to host the Bookvan on scheduled stops. Response has been slow but enthusiastic.

ISLA VISTA NEXT STEPS

- Purchase van and get special modifications completed
- Purchase books, other circulating materials; process them
- Purchase 10 Little Libraries: put together, decide if it's safe to put them out
