SUBJECT: Appointment of an Isla Vista Community Services District Representative to the City of Goleta Library Advisory Commission

RECOMMENDATION:

Ratify the Mayor's and County Board of Supervisors' selection of Marcos Aguilar to the City of Goleta Library Advisory Commission representing the Isla Vista Community Services District with a term ending June 30, 2024.

BACKGROUND:

Effective July 1, 2018, the Goleta Valley Library became a municipal library operated by the City of Goleta. On February 5, 2019, the City Council approved the creation of a Library Advisory Commission and appointed five members to the Commission. The role of the Library Advisory Commission is to advise the City Council and increase citizen participation in library issues. The Commission is comprised of five members appointed by the Mayor. The Goleta Municipal Code states that, "Three members of the Commission suggested by the County Board of Supervisors shall be appointed by the Mayor to represent the unincorporated service area of the Goleta Valley." (Goleta Municipal Code 2.14.040.) One of the three members of the Commission representing the unincorporated service area of the Goleta Valley must be a resident of the Isla Vista Community Services District. (Goleta Municipal Code 2.14.050.).

On December 7, 2020, Jay Freeman notified the Commission and staff, that due to his term ending, the Isla Vista Community Services District Board would be meeting to consider a successor for his position. On December 8, 2020, the Isla Vista Community Services District Board voted to appoint Marcos Aguilar to the Library Advisory Commission through June 30, 2024.

On February 9, 2021, the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors took action to approve the Isla Vista Community Services District's recommendation and suggested the

City of Goleta appoint Marcos Aguilar to the Library Advisory Commission to represent the Isla Vista Community Services District service area.

DISCUSSION:

This agenda item allows the City Council the opportunity to ratify the Mayor's appointment of Marcos Aguilar to the Goleta Library Advisory Commission to represent the Isla Vista Community Services District with a term ending June 30, 2024.

FISCAL IMPACTS:

There is no direct fiscal impact associated with ratifying the Mayor's appointee to the Library Advisory Commission other than the staff time needed to prepare this report.


