STATISTICS

Circulated 13,412 items in March; this is down 52.5% from last year, which is much better than the stats we've seen since starting Sidewalk Service in June 2020.

There were 426 uses of the wireless network outside of the library.






PROGRAMMING STATISTICS

46 Children's, Teen and Adult Virtual Programs were held with a total of 2,674 views.





We helped 2,286 patrons with Sidewalk Service.

The Black Gold Administrative Council voted to migrate to the Koha Automated Library System starting some time this Summer.




BUDGETS
