It appears that Winchester II has been placed as its own project as CIP No. 9018. Why is the **softball backstop** not even mentioned for repair? It has a large hole on the back side. **Piece meal construction** is prone to mistakes and is also stressful to sensitive receptors (Children using the park and wanting to play, and elderly people that want to enjoy Nature).

Page 45 states: "Bidder hereby proposes to furnish all materials, equipment, tools, labor and incidentals required for the **Miscellaneous Park Improvements CIP 9066 and 9108.** The City of Goleta has bought all the

equipment, consequently it is furnishing the play equipment and shall be responsible for all the equipment it bought and choose. Also, the City is asking for the equipment to be installed in specific locations. Since the equipment was in storage for a few years, when was it last inspected? Isn't the City liable for all the play equipment and what happens to it?

Page 49 C-9 Needs correction. The Bidder did not have anything to do with choosing the play equipment. (Since the City choose all the play equipment and where it will be installed, it is illogical for the Bidder to have sole responsibility for any damage to third party properties in the course of his work. The Contractor and the City shall share responsibility for such damages.)

Page 53 PIP Surfacing is Spectraturf and Fencing is Charlie's Fence Co. I doubt that PIP Surfacing AND Fencing will cost less than 10,000 dollars.

Page 72 Safety Data Sheet Soflex EPDM Granules #4 under Ingestion: Get medical attention immediately. This is one of the materials on Attachment 3 for "Anticipated Unitary Surfacing Material Alternate (TotTurf). As it is stated in the medical literature children ages 2-5 can experience Pica consequently, they could ingest the materials if found on the PIP or unitary surface.

Page 74 **Voramer MR 1105 Isocyanate** the lungs are a target organ. Page 82 Sensitization can cause allergic skin reaction, respiratory asthma-like symptoms and also breathing difficulties that may be life threatening Page 83 Ecological Acute toxicity to fish, algae, lettuce

Page 90 **Tire Buffings** BAS Recycling, Inc. This product contains chemicals known to the State of California **to cause cancer and birth defects** or other reproductive harm. The City needs to check for Proposition 65 warnings.

When will the public be able to see detailed plans for the ADA path and please do not forget the storm drain that runs through the entire length of the eastern side?

According to the Monarch Press Dec.2020 issue "a small berm will be created with concrete curbing to direct the water towards the natural flow of the park" which is toward Warwick Place. We repeatedly have asked for detailed drawings of this berm and for the ADA path location, but to date no answers.

I am the mother of a 5 year old and I live on Warwick place. I have lived here for 8 years and have always hoped that the playground at Winchester II Park would be improved. As of now it has only a swing set and some sand. Our neighborhood has a lot of families with young children that would greatly benefit from having a more engaging playground and I feel it would bring the community together. Now that more and more people are getting vaccinated and the pandemic is well on the way to being controlled, we all need more reasons to get children out of houses and playing out in the open.

As of now whenever I want to take my daughter to a playground, we end up getting in the car and driving to Evergreen or other parks with play structures. This is a shame, as Winchester II Open Space is just at the end of our cul-de-sac but because there are only the swings and sand it doesn't hold her interest for very long. Improving the park would make our neighborhood more walkable and reduce at least our family's carbon footprint, and perhaps other families in the area as well.

Finally, the sand at Winchester II Park is also a concern to me and my family.
