SUBJECT: Introduction of Sheriff's Office Personnel

RECOMMENDATION:

Receive an introduction to new Sheriff's Office personnel assigned to the City of Goleta.

BACKGROUND:

During the past 16 months, three new officers on the Sheriff's Office staff were assigned to positions required in the City's contract for law enforcement services. However, due to COVID-19 restrictions and the need to conduct virtual City Council meetings, these officers have not yet been formally introduced to the City Council in person. Staff suggested, and Mayor Perotte and Mayor Pro Tempore Kyriaco concurred, that these officers now be introduced to the City Council during the City first in-person City Council meeting since March of 2020.

DISCUSSION:

The new personnel who have been assigned to Goleta are Lieutenant Richard Brittingham who serves as the Chief of Police Services; Sergeant Noel Rivas, who serves as the Motors Unit Sergeant; and Deputy Ben Sandu who serves as Goleta's Community Resource Deputy.

FISCAL IMPACTS:

There are no fiscal impacts associated with the introduction of Sheriff's Office personnel assigned to the City of Goleta.
